Considerable knowledge of streets in the Jefferson Township/Blacklick area; considerable knowledge of District requirements and departmental regulations pertaining to water service; general knowledge of water meter operation; general knowledge of computerized metering system operations; general knowledge of human relations and customer service practices; general knowledge of the techniques, tools and materials used in repairing water lines; general knowledge of plumbing; some knowledge of hydraulics; ability to read and interpret manuals, graphs, charts; ability to read water meters; ability to write descriptive sentences; ability to exert one hundred (100) pounds of force; ability to speak tactfully with consumers and the general public; ability to operate computer systems and related database programs; ability to read maps, metering routes and diagrams; ability to identify and distinguish colors; ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide decimals and units of measure; ability to walk and climb stairs; ability and/or willingness to tolerate job hazards relating to inclement weather.

Completion of the twelfth school grade and two (2) years of experience reading water metering devices, planning water meter routes or assisting in the installation, maintenance, testing, inspection, repair and/or replacement of water metering systems, backflow devices and/or related items and basic understanding of the operation of a ground water treatment plant Substitution(s): A certificate of high school equivalence (GED) will be accepted in lieu of the twelfth school grade requirement.
