It's a training guide that explores what it means to be a disciple of Jesus in today's world. The authors say, "a disciple is a person who follows Jesus – **to know** Jesus and his teaching; **to grow** more like Jesus, and **to go** for Jesus, serving others and making new disciples." They also identify the five traits of a disciple: **trust, love, learning, life change, and service**. And that there are several disciplines that shape and strengthen a disciple's life.

I have decided to focus on some of those disciplines during our worship time in January 2021. And since we have to limit our activities somewhat during these challenging pandemic days, I thought it might be beneficial to think about some of the disciplines that shape a disciple and consider being more intentional about practicing them in our homes during these challenging days.

Here's where I'm headed:

January 10 – What is Worship?

January 17 - What is Discipleship?

January 24 - (The Bible – Our Manual for Living)

January 31 - What is Prayer?

My hope is that we may take the time to examine ourselves now in light of who God calls us to be as followers of Jesus; and that we might become more aware of how we can align our lives with God's vision for each of us, so that we may grow and mature as believers and servants of our Lord Jesus Christ. For as we do so, we can then become the Church God has called us to be.

Per Capita—What is it & Why Do it???

Many have asked questions about per capita, What is it? What does it support?

The Per Capita is an important aspect of how we do church. Presbyterians are proud of how our convictions inform our church function and organizational structure. As Presbyterians, we believe in "the priesthood of all believers" and acknowledge that all are called to bring their gifts and talents to God (1 Peter 2:9). And so, we champion this idea "call" throughout all levels of our denomination. On the local church level, church members are called to serve as Elders, Deacons, and pastors. Elders

and pastors of churches in geographical groupings gather as Presbyteries.

There will be a Per Capita envelope in February's envelope mailing. <u>The cost per member is \$40.82.</u> In a small but significant way, consider Per Capita as one way YOU and MARS UP CHURCH might be able to respond along with other Christians and churches across the nation, proclaiming the Gospel message that sin, separation and disunity will not have the final answer for us, our church, our denomination OR our world. The final answer is fully in the sovereign hands of God. Indeed, God is greater and more powerful than our broken and foolish ways of sin.

Installation of Elders and Deacons will be held during the worship hour on Sunday, January 17, 2021.



SESSION HIGHLIGHTS FROM DECEMBER 2020 MEETING


