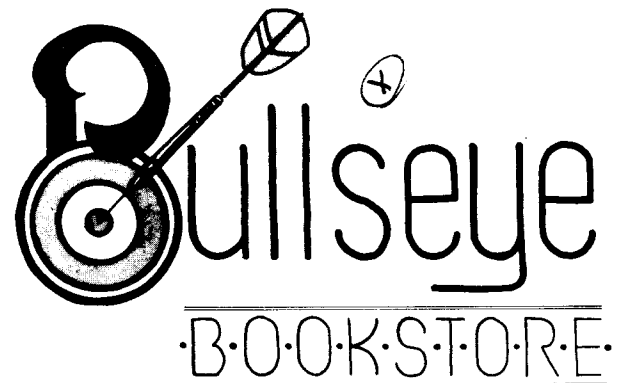
A big thanks to Debbie for volunteering her services to the D.D.A.
