

RESOLUTION 2020-06

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF FOR BUSINESSES FROM CERTAIN TOWN OF KREMMLING REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Kremmling, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Kremmling, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, Governor Jared Polis, by Executive Order, declared a statewide disaster emergency due to the presence of COVID-19 in the State of Colorado. The Executive Order identifies the potential for community spread, and, activates disaster response and recovery efforts applicable to state, local and intergovernmental disaster emergency plans; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a global pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, President Donald Trump declared a national emergency in response to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2020, Governor Jared Polis, by Executive Order, declared the State has entered the Safer-at Home phase of recovery; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2020, Grand County Board of County Commissioners submitted a written application to CDPHE to seek a variance from the state's "Safer-at-Home" public health order to allow businesses to begin reopening; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2020, the Colorado Liquor Enforcement Division issued LED Bulletin 20-7 and Emergency Liquor Regulation 47-302(F) to allow liquor licensed establishments to apply to temporarily modify their licensed premises to facilitate social distancing by employees and customers and to facilitate compliance with applicable public health orders; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees recognizes that Kremmling restaurants, brew pubs, taverns, bars, and similar establishments have been hard hit by COVID-19 and there is a growing need to reopen them to get back to work, collect sales taxes, begin to rebuild tourism, and uplift the community; and

WHEREAS, given the challenges these businesses face and their importance to our community, the Board of Trustees would like to provide these businesses temporary relief from certain requirements of the Town.

5. Staff is hereby directed to work with county and state entities to facilitate other provisions that may assist businesses with reopening in compliance with the guidelines of state or county health orders (such as relaxation of state liquor law requirements relating to modification of premise).
6. After the expiration of the provisions of this resolution, businesses must comply with any requirements of the Town Code that have been temporarily suspended.


The provisions of this resolution shall expire on October 15th, 2020, unless extended or otherwise amended by the Kremmling Board of Trustees.
