## From My Heart to You All, BE AWARE! By Wade Anderson

Over the past few months, and this is not only in my own life but MANY of yours as well, I've watched MANY brothers and sisters in the Lord leave this world as we know it. Some of our loved ones have run their race, with Jesus at the center, and finished strong to NOW stand in the presence of our LORD and Savior. That's a great thing! In fact a few months ago I shared with you all a vision that the Lord shared with me concerning the party that IS going on in heaven when even one of us steps into His glory. And again I will testify, by the vision I was shown, THAT'S AN AMAZING SIGHT TO SEE! Before we go on ...

Let's pray; "Lord Jesus we thank You for Your great and precious promises. We thank You Sir that Your Word is truth AND You ARE faithful to Your Word. Father I thank You that it's not only in my times of troubles, deep concerns or cares that I am able to come close to You for Your Help and guidance, but also I bask in Your Goodness at all times. My prayer for ALL of Your people is that we all listen carefully to You in ALL circumstances, obey even as painfully as it may seem and follow You. You ARE a Good, Good God and You want nothing more than to have 'us' walk in the fullness of every one of Your great and precious promises that You offer. And Holy Spirit, I believe that You will convey these words written here today into the hearts of God's people. That they truly reflect on their ways and their calling and NOT half step the little time we ALL have here. Again, it's Your Word that is truth and I pray the love in which I am sending this message WILL be received, with love. I believe these things to be truth, in Jesus name. AMEN."

God will always reveal truth to us individually, that's a fact. But when we share with one another what He has imparted to us it helps strengthen our belief system (faith) and understanding, believe that. WE NEED EACH OTHER! I see it like this. When ANY of us receives a message from God, through inspiration of Holy Spirit, that's the vertical part of the cross. When 'we' take that vertical message and share it with others, as I continually encourage us all to do through this newsletter, that is the horizontal part of the cross. In spite of what many of us believe a relationship with God is, it is NOT "It's all up to Him, que sera sera," where we have no input! I won't get into it right now but MANY people have a worldly understanding of 'Omnipotent and Omnipresence' and instead of 'doing something' they're always 'waiting on the Lord'.

Listen to James, from the Message translation, as he explains, "Dear friends, do you think you'll get anywhere in this if you learn all the right words but never do anything? Does merely talking about faith indicate that a person really has it? ... Isn't it obvious that God-talk without God-acts is outrageous nonsense. I can already hear one of you agreeing by saying, "Sounds good. You take care of the faith department, I'll handle the works department." Not so fast. You can no more show me your works apart from your faith than I can show you my faith apart from my works. Faith and works, works and faith, fit together hand in glove. Do I hear you professing to believe in the One and only God, but then observe you complacently sitting back as if you had done something wonderful? That's just great. Demons do that, but what good does it do them? Use your heads! Do you suppose for a minute that you can cut faith and works in two and not end up with a corpse on your hands?" (James 2:14, 17-20)

Those Scriptures alone should give us all A LOT to think about. It's a partnership that God is seeking to have with us and through us. When we do our part that indicates to Him that we believe the work Jesus did here, and on the Cross, is final. All we need to accomplish our assignments here on earth is to share His Word with others (*Matthew 28:18-20*). That completes the vertical and the horizontal message. God speaks to us all in a way that He knows we will hear. And as we take that, in the understanding that we have and share it with others ... well, it's up to Holy Spirit to take that heart touched interpretation and bring revelation truth to the person hearing or reading it. Again, from the revelation truth that I've learned and received from Dr. Tom Anderson, my spiritual father, "We are not responsible 'for' what people do with the message. We are only responsible 'to' them, to share what He has given us!!

Let me add this before we move on. It wasn't 'our' faith that saved us alone. It was Jesus' faith in Father God's decision to send Him to the Cross that 'WE' might receive Him and follow His direction! Yes, 'we' do have to believe but it was His faith that we first witnessed through Holy Spirit touching our hearts. I know for myself, when I heard Holy Spirit I did believe. But honestly I had very little understanding other than that at that point. And I most certainly couldn't even fathom I'd ever believe ALL that I believe today! Somebody say, "It's a process."

When God came to me with direction for this ministry I was confused, to say the least. I even thought to myself, "Why am I feeling like this? This voice that I'm experiencing, could it really be God? There really is a God?? So if it really is You God, what do You want from or with me?" This is what I now believe: The fact that we even wonder if we're hearing God is a great indication that He is drawing us to Him to believe. Kind of like, "Maybe God is real and maybe He 'will' use me." I'm

telling you all first hand that God will take your 'maybe' and turn it into an amazing miracle working ministry, for His glory! Not all of us are called to do a prison ministry, or pastor a church, or go to Africa on the mission field. BUT we are all called! Perhaps God is calling you to be the best mother or father to your children. Maybe He is calling you to work with other people's children, showing them the way until their own parents pull it together. Whatever your 'maybe' might be, with God in the middle, you WILL accomplish great things for the Kingdom of Heaven. With that we will move on and I will begin.

The issue that's heavy on my heart is this. And I'm going to get right to the point, without any sugar coating, because life and death ARE at stake! Even when I was in the world I observed MANY people that I thought of as 'close to me' die and not only in drug addictions but in some HORRIFIC situations where drugs were involved. And many, many of them died way before they even experienced LIFE! It did hurt me then, and a lot. Not truly knowing how to deal with these issues the liar invited me and coaxed me deeper and DEEPER into his lies to bury my emotions in even more drugs. I KNOW THAT LOTS OF YOU READING THIS HAVE BEEN OR ARE IN EXACTLY THE SAME LIES!! At one point I began tattooing MOST their names in 'bricks of a wall of remembrance' on my upper left arm thinking, "that way they would always be with me". But I too, like them, was headed in a similar direction with little or no clue of what I was throwing away. "Running hard and living my own life! Opportunity is in the fast lane!" What lie's from the pits of hell! And if this defines ANY of you reading these words, I believe it's your heart that Holy Spirit will bring REAL revelation of repentance to.

Since this re direction of life these past thirteen years I've watched so many people be released from prison, be on fire for the Lord, and slowly find themselves right back in 'the scene' and catching another even longer prison sentence or DEAD! The devil is such a liar! After being on this side of his lies for this long it gets harder and harder for me to understand WHY so many people THINK they have to go back to taste it one more time. In this, I am NOT saying when someone who hasn't tasted the love of God is having a hard time finding their way out of it, I don't understand that. I DO UNDERSTAND THAT! The WHY that's unsettling to me are the people that HAVE tasted and experienced the goodness of God and yet keep believing the lies of, "I wonder if it's changed? Just a little shot and I'm done." Friends, those are straight up deceptions, lies and traps! You know it and I know it! The dope is so full of fentanyl and who even knows what all else! For those of you that may still be interested, the dope, not only out here but you all know it first hand in there as well, is KILLING people left and right!

People everywhere are handing over their existence here on earth to the enemy over a stupid shot of drugs! PLEASE believe me, I'm NOT judging anyone, I did the same stuff for 37 years! I DO know the traps and how deep they became inside of me! That's exactly why this is so heavy on my heart. I know there's some religious folks reading this next sentence that may throw rocks and curse me for this and I really hate saying it BUT, "If you have sincerely given your life to Jesus at one point and you die from an overdose I DO believe you will still end up in heaven." BUT WHY CHOOSE TO ENTER HEAVEN IN THAT MANNER?? I'm NOT 100% convinced that God would be standing at the Gates when that person arrives with a 'Well done My good and faithful servant'. But again, those are my beliefs and opinions. GOD HAS PLANS FOR YOU!! Plans for a long and prosperous life. A life with bus loads of people for you to witness to! Selfishly, YOU will be walking streets of gold. The selfish part is, "But what about the ones that won't be there with you because YOU left your assignment too early and didn't witness to them OVER A SHOT OF DOPE!!"

This is probably NOT what you thought you were going to be reading after that introduction. But guess what? It's the message that has GOT TO BE SHARED! You people getting close to the gate, planning to get in the wrong car with drugs and alcohol from jump street ... are you willing to ante up to the consequences? ## God IS with You in the Wilderness By D.R.

I am sorry to say that it's been a long time since I've written to you, six years to be exact. All those years ago, I lost my family and the woman I was to marry to a year prison sentence. My life was at an all time low, and I didn't know how I was going to make it. I was praying and reading my Bible, but God did not take away the pain. I saw your publication and a quote was in the back, "Sometimes people can stay in your heart, but not in your life." It hit me hard! So, I wrote your ministry, you not only wrote to me, but you prayed for me. You also published my prayers, which I still have in my photo album today. Those prayers changed my life! They set my feet on solid ground, and gave me hope and a sense of direction.

I ended up being put in the first faith-based program for serious offenders in the state. I also became a chapel orderly. For two years, God moved on my life like never before. I ended up running that program. Even had a phone interview and went to be the clerk of another program at another institution. I ended up getting a paying job as the staff canteen orderly. Last two years ... best staff canteen orderly there. I even went to another unit to work as a staff canteen. For six years, you sent me your publication, birthday cards, and prayers. However, in those six years, I slowly but surely drifted away from God and away from those prayers that changed my life, all those years ago.

It's only now as I sit inside this six by twelve, hotter than ever cell, praying to Jesus that I realize how far I've come. In here I realized, your publication is the only mail I have received. It hit me like a ton of bricks, I know what God is doing, He's humbling me in the wilderness. Deuteronomy 8:2 - "Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years, to humble and test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep His commands."

Since I have been in this cell, I have found Jesus like never before. It is suffocating hot in these cells, and the people around me are losing it. Yet, I am at complete peace spending time with the Lord. I was prompted to write this to your ministry and say this with tears in my eyes, "I thank God for your ministry. It's your faithfulness and your prayers that has changed my life forever."

## Jesus Christ, the One True Living God By R.D.

"Listen, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone." - Deuteronomy 6:4 "That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the West, that there is none beside Me. I am the LORD, and there is none else." - Isaiah 45:6

With these two verses it's clear there's only one God!



#### "The LORD is my strength and song, and is become my salvation." - Psalms 118:14

## Foot's Bible Study Rotes

## Isaiah 33:10-36:22

If we are fair and honest in our relationships, we will dwell with God, and He will supply our needs. (33:14-16)

God is just as thorough in His mercy as He is severe in His judgment. God's complete moral perfection is revealed by His hatred of all sin, and this leads to judgment. This same moral perfection is revealed in His love for all He has created. This leads to mercy for those who have sinned, who have sincerely loved Jesus and put their trust in Him. (35:1)

Satan tries to confuse or deceive us. People don't necessarily need to be sinful to be ineffective for God. They need only be confused about what God wants. To avoid satan's deceit, study God's Word carefully and regularly. When you know what God says, you will not fall for satan's lies. (36:7)

## Galatians 5:14-26

When we are not motivated by love, we become critical of others. We stop looking for good in them and only see their faults. Soon the unity of believers is broken. Have you talked behind someone's back? Have you focused on someone's shortcomings instead of their strengths? Remind yourself of Jesus' command to love others as you love yourself. See *Matthew* 22:39. When you begin to feel critical of someone, make a list of that person's positive qualities. If there are problems that need to be addressed, it is better to confront in love than to gossip. (5:14-15)

## Psalm 64:1-10

We may believe that God hears only certain requests from us. While it is true that we should offer praise, confession, and respectful petitions, it is also true that God is willing to listen to anything we want to tell Him. David expressed himself honestly, knowing that God would hear his voice. God will always listen to us, and He fully understands us. (64:12)

## Proverbs 23:23

Here we read to get the truth, wisdom, discipline and discernment, this is the type of knowledge that helps us become better people and better servants to Jesus Christ. (23:23)

around us. This does not mean to be more sin conscious than God conscious though! Take heed (listen)! And remember, temptation is NOT sin. Temptation only becomes sin when you interact and partake of it!

Peter writes that there is danger beyond the physical persecution some of his readers were facing. There is a deep agenda, far beyond that of the powerful men who might inflict that persecution. The devil, not the men or women who might harm us, is the real enemy of a Christian believer. Our enemy the devil desires to devour us, to cause real and lasting harm. The Greek word here is *katapiein*, literally meaning to "swallow" or to "drown". Peter has made it clear that our place in eternity with our Father is secure. The devil cannot take that from us, but he does seek to damage our faith. He wants fear to shake our submission to the Father, and lies to distort our understanding of God's goodness. Since He cannot touch the believer's soul, satan seeks to leave us as weak and ineffective servants of our King.

In the next verse, Peter will describe how to fight that enemy. Notice, also, what he doesn't tell Christians to do. He doesn't say to live in fear. Nor does he say to live as if the reality of the devil is unimportant. We are not instructed to ignore the devil, nor to cower in the shadows. Listen here to **1 Peter 5:9**, "Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings." In other words, resist the temptation, it's a lie! Stand firmly and have faith in what you have already experienced God do in you, for you and through you. And don't think that you are the only one going through these things. The liar, satan, hates everyone of your Christian brothers and sisters just as much as he does you! It's NOT personal to you! Jesus told us, "If the world hates you, have first in what of the world, it would lave you as its own. As it is, you do not balang to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you," (John **15:18-20**)

And because you are a child of God listen here to what your God will do WHEN you tune out the lies and tune into the promises of God. *First Peter 5:10-11*, "And the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will Himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. To Him be the power forever and ever. Amen." Come on now! You can shout louder than that! Praise God! He called us and He will protect us! HALLELUJAH!!

I'm going to close with the whole chapter of **Psalm 91**. As read the first **13 verses** put yourself in the place of 'you' and 'your' with the first person 'I', 'me', or 'my'. That's what I want you to reference here. And because you are a child of God you ARE a 'Whoever'!

1 Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty,

2 I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

3 Surely He will save 'you' from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.

4 He will cover 'you' with His feathers, and under His wings 'you' will find refuge; His faithfulness will be 'your' shield and rampart.

5 'You' will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day,6 nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday.

7 A thousand may fall at 'your' side, ten thousand at 'your' right hand, but it will not come near 'you'.

8 'You' will only observe with 'your' eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.

9 If 'you' say, "The LORD is my refuge," and 'you' make the Most High your dwelling, 10 no harm will overtake 'you', no disaster will come near 'your' tent.

## 11 For He will command His angels concerning 'you' to guard 'you' in all 'your' ways; 12 they will lift 'you' up in their hands, so that 'you' will not strike 'your' foot against a stone.

I intentionally separated verses 11 and 12 to share with you that the devil, satan himself, knows the Word of God better than most of us. *Matthew chapter* 4 is where Jesus was led into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil, in verse 6 the liar said to Jesus, *"If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: 'He will command His angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."* The devil quoted *Psalm* 91:11-12 and even referenced, *"For it is written ..."* But, he quoted the Word out of context. The first time Jesus was tempted He said, *"W is written,"* But the second time when the devil came at Him with the Word of God, Jesus said, *"W is written,"* meaning that the devil was out of context with the Word. Again, in verse

8 the devil came to Jesus one last time tempting Him. And again Jesus answered him with, "Away from Ma satani For M Is written ...."

So, let's recap what just took place here in *Matthew chapter 4* and then we'll move on to the rest of *Psalm 91*. Fare enough? First off, satan was well aware of all that Jesus had been through there in the garden where He was, I believe, interceding for all of us. He'd been there for 40 days on the whole worlds behalf. When He left there Jesus didn't just wander into the desert. In obedience, He was led there by Holy Spirit. And remember, Holy Spirit doesn't do or say anything without God's direction. So why was Jesus led there by God? I believe that these were the last three things God knew Jesus would have to complete before His mission was fulfilled here on earth. I also believe these three things are the most often used temptations still today for all of us here and now!

So, what are these three things? 1) The lust of the flesh. 2) The lust of the eyes. 3) The pride of life. So, I ask you all to look at these three things closely and then you tell me if those aren't the most frequently used tactics or temptations we deal with? Instead of being content with where we're at, with what we have we WANT more than we can even endure. Without counting the cost we say "So what, we still want it." Right? What I'm saying is this. Jesus went through ALL that He did to show each and every one of us how to overcome the enemy! If Jesus was tested three times why do we believe that the devil won't do the same to us? As a matter a fact, the devil knew exactly who Jesus was, is and will always be! Sometimes we may still act a little like the world. And when we do the "enemy comes like a thief in the night" in attempts to trip us up by listening to his lies! Jesus was prepared and in these verses He shows each of us how to be prepared for temptations. FILL OURSELVES WITH THE WRITTEN WORD OF GOD!! That was Jesus' best defense and it is ours as well. The Word of God are the arrows in our quiver of defense to fire away at the devil with! I can show you all this through just this last verse, *Matthew 4:11, "Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him."* Jesus did it and Peter re iterated it in **1 Peter 5**, telling us, resist the devil, stand firm in our faith and he will flee from us? Let's continue.

## 13 'You' will tread on the lion and the cobra; 'you' will trample the great lion and the serpent.

Believe me, the devil watches our walks to see that they line up with the words that we confess. So 'we' MUST believe in our hearts and confess with our mouths, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in Whom I trust" and IMMEDI-ATELY God steps in, comes to our rescue and answers the devil with ...

#### 14 "Because he loves Me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges My name.

15 He will call on Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.

#### 16 With long life I will satisfy him and show him My salvation."

I pray you all know by now that every time God says, "I will," it's His promise to us. So look at just these last three verses for a second. Not once, not twice, but six times in three verses God promises "I will!" That right there ought to be getting a lot of us excited! Somebody say, "It's a process." "It's a process" that we do NOT go through by ourselves. Both the New Testament and the Old Testament, Hebrews 13:5 and Deuteronomy 31:6 clearly state, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." And Hebrews 13:8 verifies, whether Old Testament or New, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever."

I'll end with this plea, "Please, please, please do not allow yourselves to fall to the temptations of the devil! Even if a loved one or family member that you may be getting released or paroled to are still living the life you were already set free from, steer clear. Let me say it like this. You need Jesus to be first in your life before anyone or anything else! If Jesus is NOT first in your life and you instead think you can half step it, all those other relationships will pick up right where you left them and NEVER grow to the place that God has designed for both you and them." We love you ALL deeply and know that God has placed this on my heart. God would have me write this message if it were to touch even a single one of your hearts! Believe that! Is it you?? See you next month.
