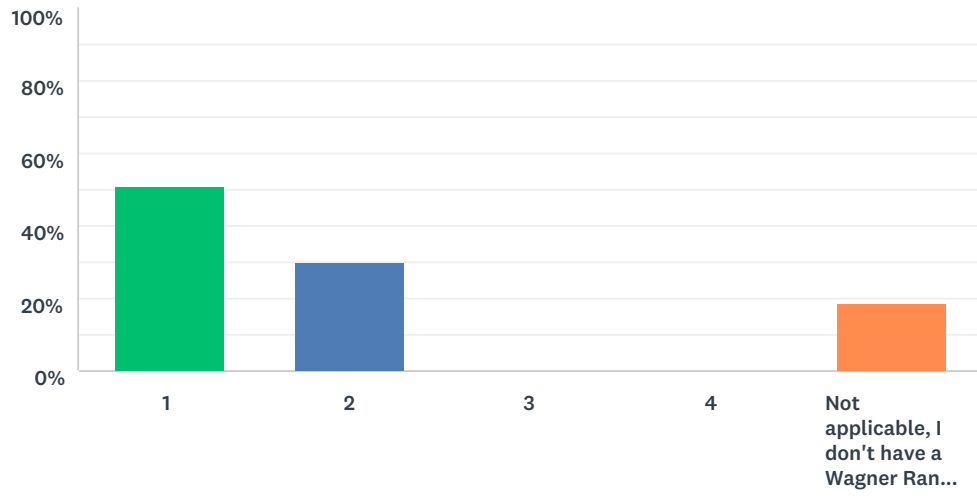

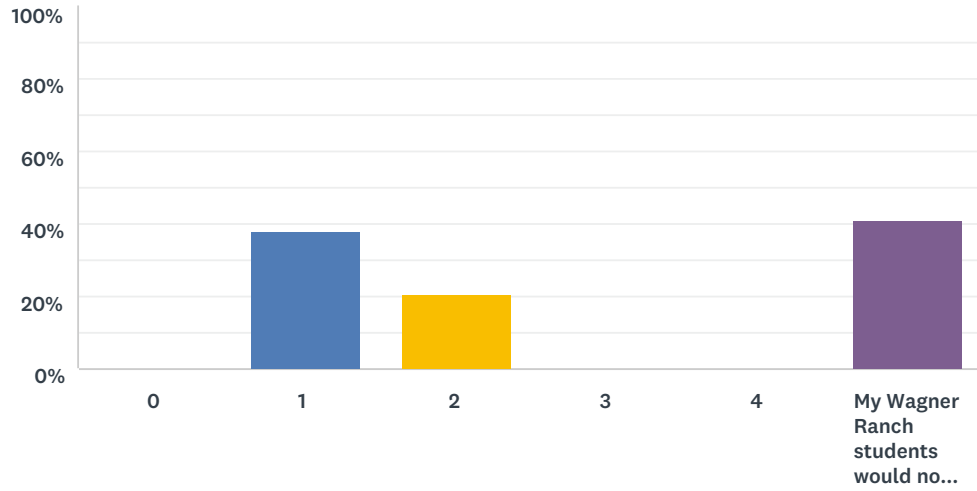

## Q2 How many Wagner Ranch students would use a bus stop at OPP?

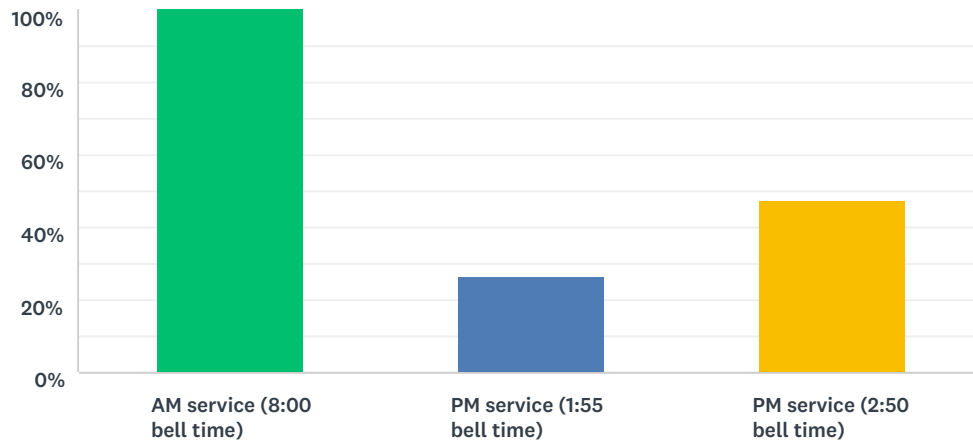

### Q3 Which service would your Wagner Ranch student most likely use at the OPP bus stop? (click all that apply)

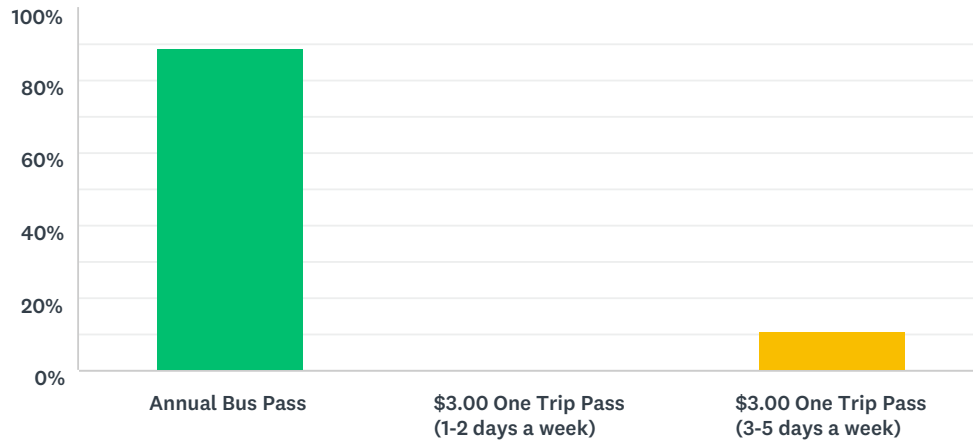

### Q4 What type of pass would your Wagner Ranch students most likely use for the OPP bus stop? (click all that apply)

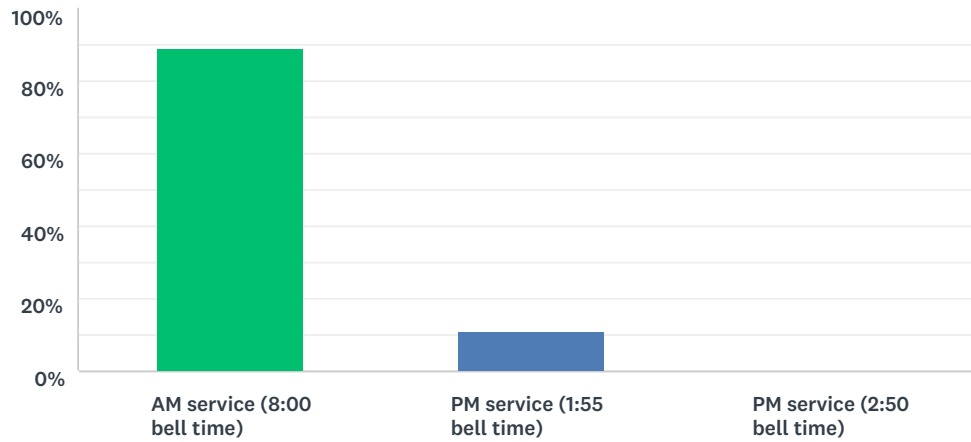

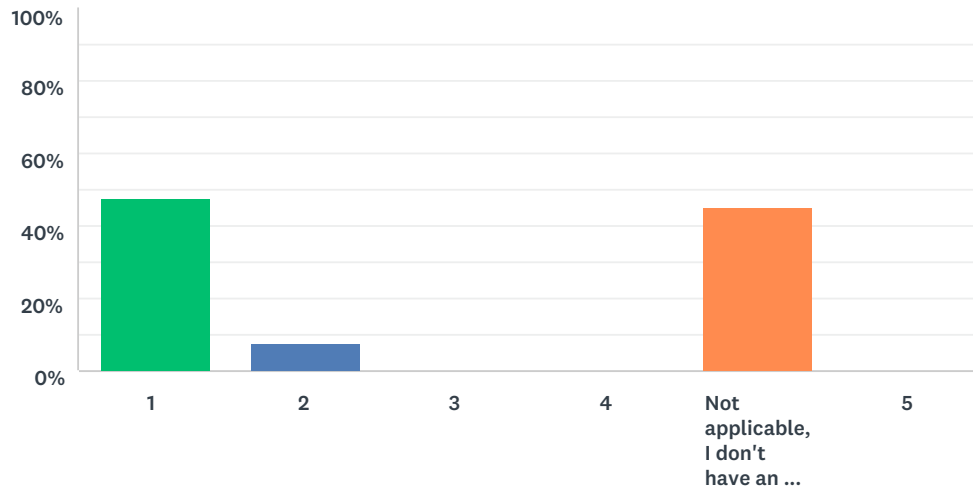

### Q6 How many OIS students reside in your household?

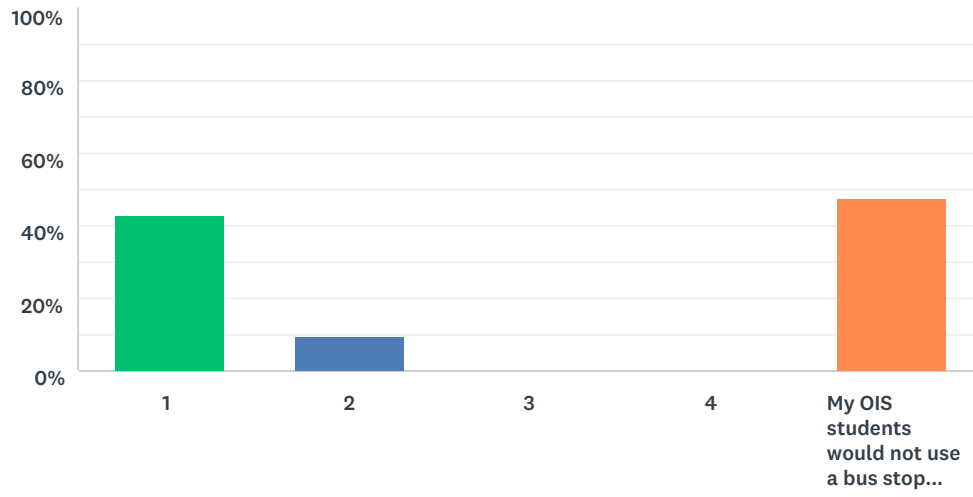

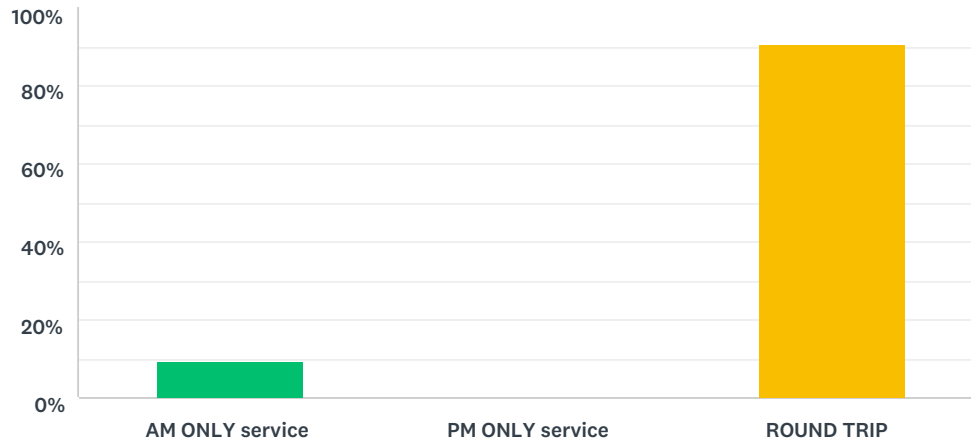

### Q8 Which service would your OIS student most likely use at the OPP bus stop?

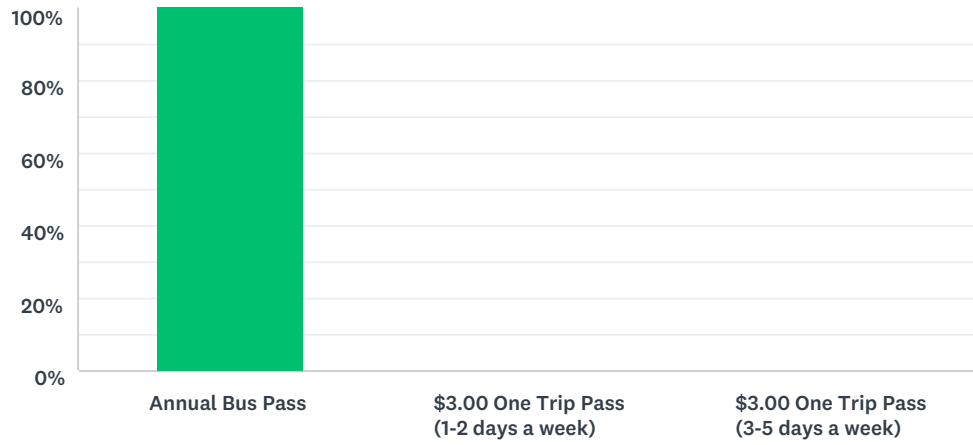

### Q9 For your OIS students, would you most likely use: (click all that apply)

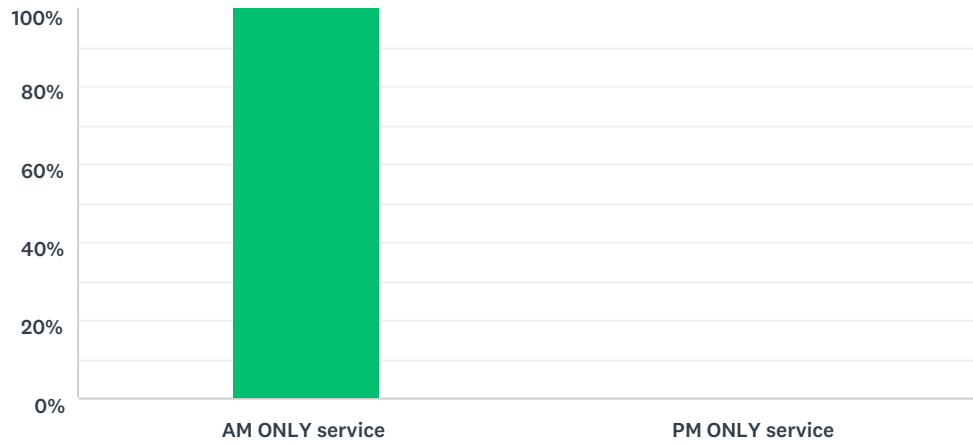

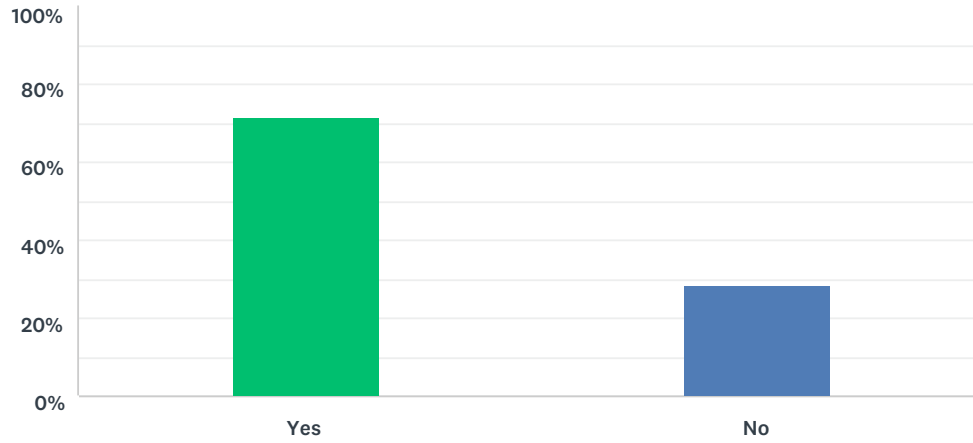

### Q11 Are you a member of the OPP?

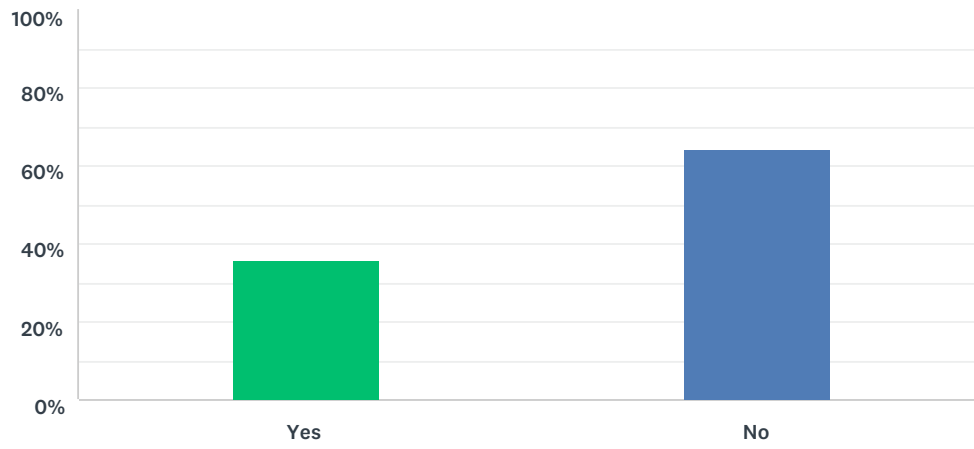
