Student Qualifications – your first step in the Bravo application process

- ❖ You must be in or have been in the Michigan Foster Care system.
- ❖ You must be 18 through 24 years of age on or before the year in which you are applying for this scholarship.
- ❖ You must be enrolled AND accepted in an accredited post-secondary education program.
- ❖ If you have any changes in your contact information, please contact us immediately so it does not slow the process for your consideration.

If you are a first-time applicant, or a repeat scholarship recipient who is changing schools, you must complete all sections of the application.

If you are a repeat scholarship recipient and are not changing schools, you must complete:

- ❖ Section 1
- ❖ Section 2 less school transcripts and acceptance letter, and
- ❖ Section 3

Application due dates are as follows:

- Fall Semester: July 1st
- Winter Semester: October 1st
- Spring/Summer Semester: March 1st
