AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The purpose of the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as any employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- <u>Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.</u>
- Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition.
- Eligibility restriction apply to all members of the same household.

Novice Junior: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate: For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate: For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition present in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior: For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior: For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old on the day of the show, and who have won 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for the year has passed all participants return to the Open class for the following year.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE

ALL JUNIOR HANDLERS ARE REQURED TO HAVE AN AKC NUMBER PRIOR TO THE DAY OF THE EVENT. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, call (919) 816-3776. Junior handlers must put their nine digit number on the entry blank. Be sure to include all information required on both the front and back of the official AKC entry form.

Sanctioned Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition Regulations Amended by AKC Board of Directors October 2019 (effective February 7, 2020)

Section 1- Classifications The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility Entry and eligibility requirements include:
☐ The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows or conformation B- matches at the option of the show giving club.
☐ Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
☐ Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
☐ AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
☐ All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
☐ Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. A recording fee of .50 cents per dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only.

 Entries must reach show secretary, Kathy Hand, 315 S. 163rd St., Gilbert, AZ., 85296, Wednesday, February 17, 2021, 9:00 PM, MST. Fees must accompany entries.

3. The club and/or Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.

4. The club and/or the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class which the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly, or for entering the same dog twice. No refunds of \$5.00 or less will be made.

5. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$4.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.

6. Foreign exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.

7. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee.

8. Entry fees will NOT be refunded if it is impossible to open or complete the show because of riots, civil disturbance, fires, an act of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or other acts or cause beyond the control of the club.

9. The Grand Canyon State Bernese Mountain Dog Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against the Club or any official thereof.

10. Returned checks or post dated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.

11. Entries not on official AKC Entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies a condition to acceptance.

12. Owners are to have their dogs ready to go into the ring promptly, so judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only to be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler. Waiting for dogs is a courtesy extended to owners and handlers. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring.

13. Owners must familiarize themselves with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books may be obtained from A.K.C., 5580 Centerview Dr., Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.

14. The Grand Canyon State Bernese Mountain Dog Club, its Show Secretary or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

15. The Grand Canyon State Bernese Mountain Dog Club does not agree to arbitrate claims set forth on official AKC entry form for this event.

16. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest judging at the Show.

17. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.

18. Trophies, prizes and cash will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the classes and breed to the person showing the dog.
