To apply for a certificate of Occupancy, you must contact either Jack Wood (229) 276-2913 or Lin Mercer (229) 276-2911 with the Office of Community Development. They will, in turn, inspect the property in question. If approved for the use in which you are intending, they will then write the Certificate of Occupancy.
