Carl A. Werth, 93, of Sebewaing, died Saturday, Jan. 25, 2003, at Munson Hospital in Traverse City following a week-long illness. He was born March 23, 1909 in Unionville, son of the late Adolph and Ida (Rich) Werth. He was united in marriage to Elsie M. Stoll on April 26, 1932 in Sebewaing. She preceded him in death on Jan. 24, 2000. He was a graduate of Michigan Agricultural College in East Lansing with a degree in dairy management and butter making.
