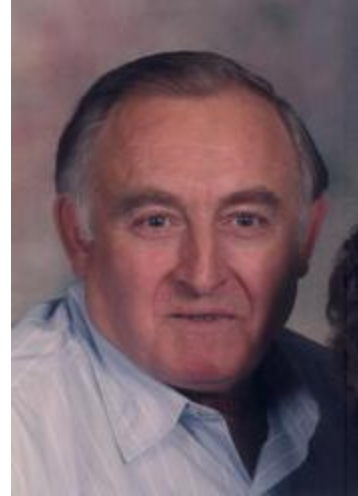


Robert L. Schember

Robert L. Schember age 83, of Elkton died peacefully early Wednesday morning, January 8, at his home.
