6:00 p.m.: The above named Planning Commissioners were present at the public forum held at 5 Village Lodge Rd. at Stratton Mountain, as warned, hosted by the Manchester Ranger District of the Green Mountain National Forest. The purpose of this forum was to address ongoing plans for the National Forest's Somerset Integrated Resource Project. This upcoming project involves various plans for the area surrounding Somerset Reservoir and the Deerfield River watershed, intended for implementation in 2020. David Francomb, the Manchester District Ranger, gave an overview of the project and encouraged locals and adjacent property owners to consider coordinating their land management with the National Forest's plans. Following the presentation, attendees were directed to visit a number of displays set up around the conference room and to meet with specialists and personnel assigned to various aspects of those projects, in order to learn details of the plan.

Following the forum, the Planning Commission agreed to postpone other agenda items to next meeting. The meeting adjourned at 7:00pm.
