Sublett made the motion to award Hurley and Fidler second the motion. Motion passed. Sublett stated that Brett Hurley had informed him they would have to go to Hendrick's County for asphalt. Putnam county's has already shut down.

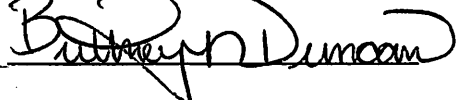

A letter and a phone call will be made to the winning bidders.

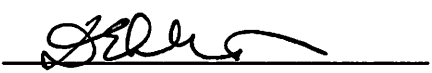

**President Don Sublett called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and Attendance was called. President Don Sublett, Council Coweta Patton, Larry Fidler were present. Vice President Gary Benninton and Dennis Padgett was absent also present was Clerk Treasurer Cheryl Galloway and Attorney Allan Yackey.**

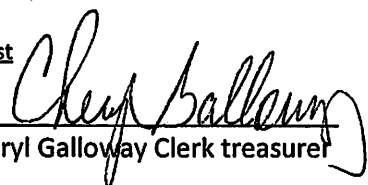
**A quorum being established, the meeting proceeded as follows.**

Don had a meeting with Brent the Wastewater plant superintends and Brent expressed an urgency to hire someone to help him at the wastewater plant. Brent feels like being under an Agreed order that he cannot keep up with his work load. If IDEM would come to the plant they could be arrested. Don wants to go ahead and hire Mark Couch a former employee of 5 months as part time and disregard the Ordinance 2013-8 having one years experience. Don has an applicant that is highly experience that could be hired now. Alan told the board that since we passed the Ordinance to change it you must have four members present and there is not. The Utility Manger should be doing this stuff. Don stated in a conversation with Brent that the wastewater superintend should report to the Town President not the Utility Manager. Alan stated he is not aware of other Towns practices. Don asked Richard what he was doing to correct this problem? Richard stated he asked the council to amend the Salary Ordinance to bring Mark back at \$12.00 an hour. Alan stated it is not good to make the Ordinance for one single person. Alan asked how desperate the situation was because to have an emergency meeting means there is no one to man the Wastewater plant. Richard stated he and Brent will work Saturday and Richard will cover it Sunday. Richard told the council that if we leave Mark couch out he has one more applicant and the applicant does not have a CDL or experience. Larry asked Brent how much help Mark will be to Brent. Brent stated a tremendous help. Larry asked Brent how long to train someone. Everyone is different Brent has to feel comfortable two to three weeks. Mike Clark suggested to redo the Ordinance starting someone at the top of the bracket would cause trouble with his employee it should be \$12.00 an hour not a bracket. Mike Clark suggested bring him back for two weeks until the next meeting to fix this problem. Alan and Don felt this was a good solution. Richard wanted to know what the emergency was. again Alan asked the council if this is something that cannot be dealt with over the week end then this is not an Emergency and should end now.
