# Featured Artist: Linden Kirby



Linden Kirby started painting for family and friends at a young age, but not until a few years ago was he able to take up a brush on a regular basis. And strictly speaking, it's not always a brush that he paints with. He enjoys painting and mark-making with credit cards and putty knives, string, plastic wrap, manipulative tools and other inventive ways of expression on paper and canvas. Watercolor is Linden's primary medium, but he also enjoys the challenge of new media and techniques that improve the quality and enjoyment of art. He finds inspiration most often in the beauty of God's creation, so landscapes, trees, and nature are favorite subjects. And since he and his family travel across the US and

Europe, these scenes also find their way into his work.

Linden believes that art touches the heart when it tells a story, evokes an emotion, or brings back a memory. So, he chooses his subjects carefully and paints with the idea of telling a story through the image and the medium.

Linden also enjoys teaching workshops, giving demonstrations for local art clubs, and encouraging other artists. You may contact him through his website, **ArtByLinden.com**, with questions or if you want more information about a demo for your art club or jurying an exhibition. Commissions are accepted.

Linden is a Signature Member of the Colorado Watercolor Society, a member of the American Watercolor Society, Paletteers, Broomfield Art Guild, and Foothills Art Center.

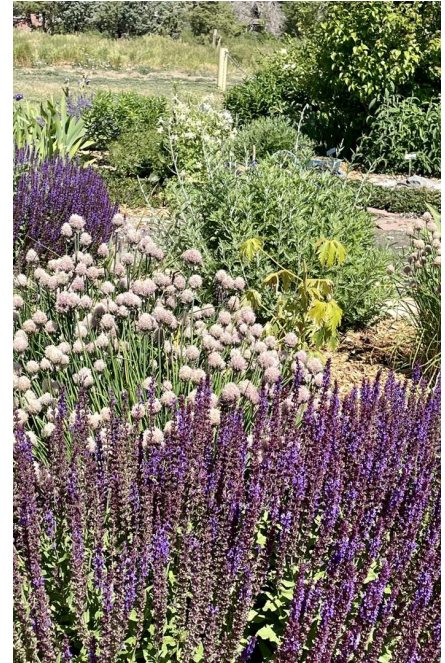
We also tap into the Master Gardeners to help us teach both Garden Basics and Family Learn

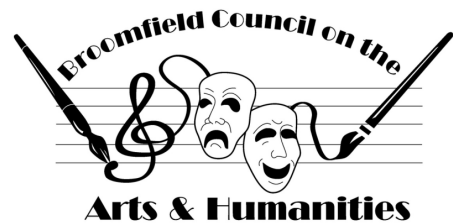

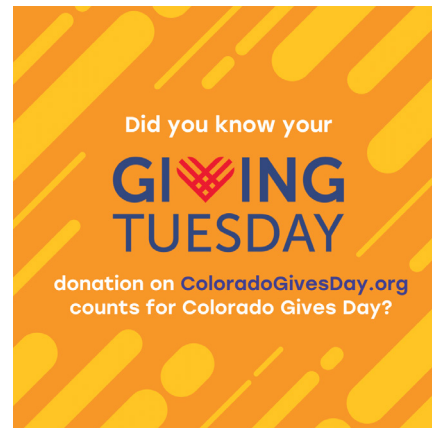
