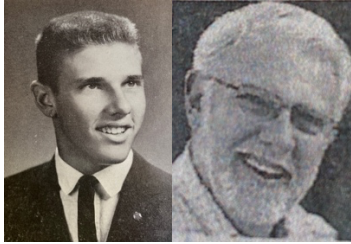


ROGERS, Mitchell Calvin III "M.C."
