OCIA - An Invitation to Come Please pray for our catechumens and candidates.


As we prepare to enter into the season of Lent, our catechumens and candidates are entering a final and more intense time of preparation. It is considered a period of purification and enlightenment and will include two of the three scrutinies. These are solemn rites which give spiritual strength to the catechumens.

On March 8 our catechumens will participate in the Rite of Election at the Cathedral of the Madeleine. This marks the time when the catechumens will affirm their commitment to enter the Church. After this rite, they are called the elect as they journey through Lent and towards their sacraments of initiation.

Weekly sessions are held covering topics that help them grow in faith. The topics for March are: Lent (3/2/25), Anointing of the Sick (3/11/25), Catholic Social Teaching (3/16/25), Faith and Creed (3/23/25), and Salvation (3/30/25).
