Section 2: How to Register

WE NOW USE AN ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM. PARENTS/GUARDIANS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO REGISTER THEIR CAMPERS. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE INTERNET ACCESS TO DO SO, FEEL FREE TO CALL OUR OFFICE AND WE WILL REGISTER YOUR CAMPER(S) OVER THE PHONE.

FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY, EACH CAMPER MUST BE FULLY REGISTERED <u>BY THE LAST DATED LISTED FOR EACH CAMP</u> SESSION (1 WEEK BEFORE CHECK-IN DATE) OR THEY MAY NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND

- 1. Navigate to the "Programs & Events" page on our website at www.camparrahwanna.org and click "Register Here"

 If you do not have internet access, please call our office ASAP and we will register your camper over the phone.
- 2. <u>If this is your first time using the online system</u>, select the green "Register" option and create an account with your (parent/guardian) information. Once your information is complete, you can then register yourself or others for a program.
- 3. <u>If you have already created an account</u> for a previous program, select the gray "Login" button. After entering your email and password, you will then be able to ADD A NEW PROGRAM TO EXISTING CAMPERS, or add new campers.
- 4. In order to ensure that our excellent counseling staff is in place and ready for your campers, registrations will NOT be accepted after the Monday one-week prior to check-in unless qualified counselors are available at that time

Instead, please CONNECT WITH YOUR CHURCH representative to find out how much of the fee is your responsibility then PAY YOUR CHURCH directly for your camper's registration fee

When your child's online registration is complete, CAW will notify your church. If your church agrees that they "know" your campeter a "Church Voucher" will be added to your campet's online account. IT WILL STILL BE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CONNECT WITH YOUR CHURCH AND PAY THEM FOR ANY AGREED REGISTRATION FEES.

OPTION 2: PAY CAMP ARRAH WANNA

WE ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTING ONLINE CREDIT CARD OR E-CHECK PAYMENTS

Include CAMPER'S NAME & CAMP SESSION on the memo line.

When sending one check for multiple campers, NOTE THE AMOUNT THAT SHOULD BE APPLIED TO EACH CAMPER. You will receive an email notice once a payment is received and processed by the CAW office.

6. PAYMENT OF BALANCE IS DUE AT OR BEFORE CHECK-IN

7. Cancellations made at least (2) two weeks before camp are eligible for a refund of all but a \$50 processing fee Refunds will NOT be issued for cancellations made less than (2) two weeks prior to session, except in the case of illness or injury

DISCOUNTS will be applied during online registration

- a. Early Registration: All campers who are fully registered on or before June 17th will receive the above-stated \$20 discount (the price will increase by \$20 after date noted above)
- b. Sibling discount: \$10 off each registration if (2) or more siblings per immediate family signs up for camp
- c. NEW CAMPER discount: \$20 off if you have never attended a Camp Arrah Wanna program before

Scholarships

- a. Please contact your local church for scholarship availability first
- b. If you aren't connect with a church, or they are not able to provide a scholarship, don't worry! Just follow these steps:

CAW believes it is important for each camper/family to contribute SOMETHING towards their camp cost, but we never want people to miss out on this special opportunity because of an inability to pay the full registration fee. Because of that commitment, a partial scholarship will ALWAYS e awarded to any camper who takes the time to complete all 3 of these steps:

- 1. Request the CAW Scholarship Application Paperwork
- 2. Fill it out entirely
- 3. Submit it to the CAW office via email, snail-mail, our website, or fax

CAW Scholarships will not be awarded to individuals without completed paperwork on file.

Once the CAW Scholarship amount is confirmed, we will notify you via email about remaining balance & payment option

Section 3: Transportation

*** CAW will NOT be providing bus transportation to or from camp this 2019 Summer Camp ***

If you would like assistance in finding a ride, please call or email us at least 2 weeks before check-in so we can connect you with someone in your area who may be able to assist you.

If you or your church are providing your camper's transportation to and/or from Arrah Wanna, please note the check-in and check-out times in Section 1.

Section 4: What to Bring & NOT to Bring

- 1. Sleeping bag / bedding / pillow / PJ's
- 2. Personal hygiene toiletries and towels
- 3. Rain jacket
- 4. Sturdy shoes for general camp use
- 5. Flip-flops or sandals for pool area / shower shoes
- 6. Modest Swimwear

- 7. Shorts for warm days / pants for cool nights
- 8. Warm sweatshirt & jacket for cool nights
- 9. Bible, notebook and pen/pencil
- 10. Flashlight
- 11. Bug spray
- 12. Money for the camp store/canteen (CAW t-shirts = \$15)
- * Bring shoes or clothing that you do not mind getting dirty, muddy or wet
- * All items should be labeled with the campers name and phone number. Arrah Wanna cannot be held responsible for personal items that are lost, left behind, or stolen.
- * High School campers are encouraged to bring "funky" (and classy) dress clothes for a special evening activity.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS TO CAMP WITH YOU:

- Non-prescription drugs or drug paraphernalia; alcohol of any kind; tobacco of any kind; marijuana of any kind
 Prescriptions medications must be checked in with Medical Personnel at check-in and will be administered as
 per Dr. and/or Guardian instructions.
- 2. Weapons: firearms, swards, knives, etc.
- 3. Inappropriate clothing: here are some examples:

Swimwear: if you have a two-piece bathing suits, you will be asked to wear a t-shirt/tank-top over it; no Speedo's! You will be asked to change into something more appropriate if your t-shirt has explicit pictures or words on it Shorts, dresses and skirts need to be a modest length (fingers don't touch skin if hanging your arms down to your side) Arrah Wanna leaders reserve the right to ask any camper to change their clothes at any time Let's dress in a way that is respectful to God, ourselves and each other!

ITEMS OF VALUE ARE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY!

Cell phones, tablets, music players, video games, electronics, etc. can have a negative effect on your experience at camp just as easily as a positive one. If these items are used in a way that make others feel excluded, distract you from any activities, and/or disturb group time, the CAW staff & leadership reserves the right to ask you to put them away for the remainder of camp. It is important to be engaged in the program while at camp at all times. Our leaders work hard to make the program relevant to all campers, and we know electronics are an important way to stay connected to family and friends - but this is a unique opportunity to step away from every-day life and see things from a new (and less-distracted) prospective.

Section 6: Health Information

Trained/certified medical personnel and nearby clinics assure that you are well taken care of while at Arrah Wanna. If there are any changes / additions to your medical form, please contact the camp office prior to your arrival at camp. ALL medications (prescription & OTC) must be registered with the medical staff upon check-in. Perscription medicine must be in the original container with the original labeling. Your insurance is primary. Unless prescribed by a doctor, please do not check-in fluoride, as it creates too much work for the medical staff than is necessary. Thank you!
