DESCRIPTION: Great performing BP bow. White facing limbs (have traditional yellowing that comes with age); brown back limbs. This is some discoloration in the varnish near the top of the grip. This Mustang has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. No drilled holes. No chips or cracks. There is one superficial ding on the limb above the riser (see pic on page 3). No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age
