DENTAL CLEANINGS !

We are now proudly offering affordable dental cleanings for your furry friends age 8 years old and younger. We require that your pet must already be spayed or neutered to take advantage of this service. Your pet must be current on the core vaccines listed above (3 for dog, 2 for cat), but we can update them at the time of dental cleaning. If you have recently had your pet fixed, we ask that you wait at least 4 weeks before scheduling their dental to allow the anesthesia to wear off and for healing. We cannot do the dental at the same time as your pet's surgery as it will increase risk for surgery site infection. Other services offered are also available at the time of the dental cleaning (ex. Microchipping, heartworm testing, FeLV/FIV testing, fecal exam, deworming, nail trims, anal gland expression)

We do not offer teeth extractions or dental x-rays, but if your pet needs them, we can offer a referral to a primary care veterinarian for additional treatment. Depending on the severity of your pet's existing dental disease, we may decline your dental procedure the morning of your appointment in order to refer you directly to a dental specialist.

FERAL CATS (TNR ONLY)

**These prices are in place to help with the control of truly feral cats that are to be Trapped, Neutered/Spayed, and Released (TNR). Ear tipping these cats is important so if they get caught again, it is clear that the cat has already been fixed and avoids unnecessary surgery. If you do not want ear tipping and are trying to make a feral cat a pet, please refer to Cat Services above.*

**A feral cat may be brought in Mon-Thurs at 7am with no appointment needed. No more than two feral cats can be brought in by a client per day.*

**Each feral cat MUST arrive in a feral cat trap, one cat per trap (this is for their safety for ours). Cat traps can be purchase online or borrowed from Cabarrus County Animal Control*

PUBLIC SURGERIES – TO SCHEDULE YOUR SURGERY SPOT, PLEASE CALL US AT (704) 784-6304. WE DO NOT ACCEPT WALK-INS. WE REQUIRE FULL PAYMENT TO BOOK YOUR APPOINTMENT AND HOLD YOUR SLOT. YOU CAN STILL ADD ADDITIONAL SERVICES THE MORNING OF SURGERY. ONCE SURGERY IS SCHEDULED, YOU CAN RESCHEDULE 1 TIME BEFORE LOSING YOUR PRE-PAYMENT AS LONG AS YOU NOTIFY US 24 HOURS BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT. NO-SHOWS MORNING OF SURGERY MAY LOSE THEIR PRE-PAYMENT.
