MINUTES

The February 13, 2018 regular meeting of the Innsbrook Board of Trustees was held at Innsbrook Village Hall and called to order at 5:00 PM with Chairman Thomsen presiding. Chairman Thomsen led the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon Roll Call, Trustees Trish Dunn, Jerry Rust, Ted Sator, Tom Stevener and Jeff Thomsen were present. After roll call, Chairman Thomsen announced that a quorum was present for the transaction of business.

Also in attendance were Village Administrator/Clerk, Carla Ayala, Allen Huddleston (2 Oakwood Est.); Mark Lowrance (15609 Walkers Way); Don Zuhone (4 Oakwood Est.) and Donna West (1 Elysium).

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motioned by Trustee Stevener, seconded by Trustee Rust, to approve the agenda. All Trustees present voted "Aye". Motion passed and approved with a 5-0 vote.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motioned by Trustee Stevener, seconded by Trustee Rust to approve minutes. All Trustees present voted "Aye". Motion passed and approved with a 5-0 vote.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Residents present spoke about wanting the Village to leave them alone. They oppose stricter wastewater regulations and more Government being forced upon them.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

- a. Financial Report The financial report and the bills of the month were distributed and viewed by all Trustees in attendance. Motioned by Trustee Stevener, seconded by Trustee Rust to approve the financial report and pay all the bills of the month. All Trustees present voted "Aye". Motion passed and approved with a 5-0 vote.
- b. Administrator's Report Carla Ayala presented her report to the Trustees. The Village's six month financial statement was published in the Warren County Record on January 18, 2018. Two Candidates, Ted Sator and Tom Stevener, have filed for the two trustee positions available during the April 3, 2018 election. Therefore, the Village will not hold an election for Trustees positions in April. Carla Ayala will be attending the MoCCFOA Spring Institute in Columbia, MO from March 12-15, 2018, Village Hall will be closed during that time. The building permit report for the fourth quarter of 2017 was provided to the Trustees. Eleven permits were issued during the fourth quarter, resulting in fifty-three total permits issued for the 2017 calendar year.
- c. Planning and Zoning Commission A meeting was held on February 7, 2018. Janet Postlewait was officially sworn in as a Planning and Zoning Commissioner during that meeting. Planning and Zoning Commission Chairman, Allen Huddleston, read a recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission to the Trustees as follows, "After extensive review, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the Village of Innsbrook recommends that an amendment to the Zoning Regulations, Appendix A, regarding On-site Wastewater Treatment Systems is not required at this time. The Planning and Zoning Commission listened to concerns from numerous Village residents and from the CEO of Innsbrook Corporation. It was determined that following the current requirements and regulations as outlined in Appendix A of the Village of Innsbrook Zoning Regulations which adopts the "Missouri Laws Accompanied by Department of Health and Senior Services Rules Governing Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems", will be sufficient for the Village of Innsbrook moving forward at this time."

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

a. Village Cemetery - Multiple residents have mentioned the need of a Village Cemetery. The Trustees will continue to look into, and discuss at a future date.

Meeting adjourned into executive session at 5:59 PM.
