13th Anniversary Golf Tournament Rules

1. A scramble means that all team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker. At least three drives from each team member must be used.

2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot.

3. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green.

4. Putts need to be placed within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.

5. You may lift, clean, and place your ball within one club length on the selected shot; however, you may not move your ball out of a hazard (including bunkers), out of the rough, from the fairway or rough to the apron or from the apron to the green.

6. Only the first hole-in-one on Hole #2 will win the prize.

7. The Pot of Gold hole, #15, has a 5ft radius. Golfers buy a \$5 chance at the tee. Within the pot of gold get double your money.

8. On Hole # 8 you can have the pro drive your ball for \$5.

9. The longest drive hole is #11. If your drive is longer than the current long drive, move the marker to your drive location.

10. Mulligans can be bought for \$5. One per golfer; cannot be used on Holes 2, 11, or 15; otherwise, use where you want but only on the drive.
