

# "The Resurrection and Hope for the Most Hardened of the Lost"

"...Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, he was buried, he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures..." 1 Corinthians 15:3-4

Ayaan Hirsi Ali is the most unlikely of Christian converts. She was born in Mogadishu, Somalia, in 1969. Her father was an Islamic scholar. He escaped imprisonment from the Communists in that country and brought the family to Nairobi in 1980. There Ayaan was enrolled in an Islamic school. She enthusiastically embraced Islam. She wore a hijab. She expressed support for the Muslim Brotherhood.

Under threat of a forced marriage she sought asylum in the Netherlands. She was 23. She began to read and study a variety of subjects beyond her earlier explorations. She also picked up other languages quickly. She is today fluent in six languages. She was accepted at Leiden University in the Netherlands and proved to be a scholar. She received a Masters degree in political science. During this time she was helping other Somali refugees in the Netherlands.

As a result of her study and personal experiences she was becoming disillusioned with Islam. When the attacks in the US on 9/11 occurred, she studied the work of Osama bin Laden. She decided to break away from Islam. In 2002 she declared herself to be an atheist. In 2003 she was elected to the Dutch parliament. She spoke and wrote about Islam. She began receiving death threats. A colleague who helped her produce a film critical of Islam was murdered. She went into hiding for a time.

In 2006 she moved to the US. She was invited to become a research fellow at Harvard. She became connected with a group of scholars known as the New Atheists. She joined many of them at the 2012 Global Atheist Convention. But then something happened.

She describes it in her own words: "I had a personal crisis... I lived for about a decade with intense depression and anxiety, self-loathing. I hit rock bottom. I went to a place where I actually didn't want to live anymore, but I wasn't brave enough to take my own life. I was self-medicating. Over a long period of time, I saw psychiatrists and other doctors. I was trying to understand my condition and I was trying to treat it with the help of pure evidence-based science.."

"I saw one therapist who said, 'Perhaps you have something else.' She described it as 'spiritual bankruptcy,' and that resonated with me. And having reached a place where I had absolutely nothing to lose, I prayed, and I prayed desperately. And for me, that was a turning point. And what happened after that is a miracle in its own right."

In a recent interchange with atheist professor Richard Dawkins, Hirsi Ali declared, "It has to go back to, 'Is there something or is there nothing' I choose to believe that Jesus rose from the dead." That's the Easter story. If there is hope for a Muslim and atheist like Hirsi Ali, there is hope for your resistant relative and coworker and neighbor and friend. He is risen!


## **CHURCH HIKE**


## "Last Supper With Jesus"
