OUR FUTURE

The future can look frightening to children whose parents have been seriously or fatally injured at work. Already confronting difficult emotions, the children often must confront the hurdle of funding their education beyond high school—the key to their future and ours.



KIDS' CHANCE, Inc. of Missouri is a non-profit organization that provides scholarships to the children of workers who have been seriously or fatally injured in a compensable Missouri work accident.

YESTERDAY

The first KIDS' CHANCE began in Georgia almost a decade ago with the help of an insurance company executive whose father was killed in a work-related accident.

KIDS' CHANCE, Inc. of Missouri was established in 1996 with the help of workers' compensation professionals and a generous \$25,000 gift from Travelers Insurance Company. Since that time, this worthy organization has awarded more than \$250,000 in scholarships.

In 1998, the Missouri Legislature recognized KIDS' CHANCE, Inc. of Missouri by establishing a state scholarship endowment to be developed over 10 years. At the end of 10 years, the interest will be used to fund

additional scholarships for children of Missouri workers who are seriously or fatally injured in Missouri work accidents.

TODAY

KIDS' CHANCE, Inc. of Missouri provides scholarships for many types of continuing education. The majority of scholarships are awarded for traditional college and university programs. Scholarships are also awarded for vocational and technical education.

To qualify for a scholarship, applicants must have a parent who was seriously or fatally injured in a compensable work-related accident and must demonstrate the need for financial assistance.

KIDS' CHANCE, Inc. of Missouri is a diverse group working together to achieve a common goal. Volunteers representing employers, insurers, labor, state government, medical care providers, and both plaintiff and defense attorneys raise funds, award scholarships and manage the organization. KIDS'

CHANCE, Inc. of Missouri is run primarily by volunteers. More than 90 percent of the funds raised are used for scholarships.

KIDS' CHANCE volunteers have organized many successful fundraising events throughout the state including golf tournaments, cosmic bowling events and continuing legal education seminars. The KIDS' CHANCE, Inc. of Missouri Board of Directors continues to develop new fundraising ideas and identify new scholarship candidates.
