Dear Parents and Students,

Our yearly recital preparation has begun. It is the culmination of this year's training and is an exciting event, which is met with enthusiasm by the dancers, instructors and audience. You'll see smiles gleaming and confidence beaming as the dancers take the stage. It's truly a fun and rewarding experience that you don't want to miss. (Although it is not a requirement, we strongly suggest that each student take part in our annual recital.)

The recital will be **Friday, June 14 at 7PM** and **Saturday, June 15 at 1PM at King Philip High School Auditorium.** There will be an admittance charge for all attending the recital. This cost is necessary for the rental of the auditorium, changing areas, lighting and other essential expenses. Ticket information will be given at a later date. Since most dances are done in formation with partners, etc., **it is ESSENTIAL that students appear in BOTH performances with the exception of our Toddler Time and Pre Ballet classes.** Toddler Time and Pre Ballet will appear in the Saturday matinee show only. All students must agree to stay backstage during the entire show and can watch the show as it's happening on the television in the cafeteria. The dancers can also see the show from the audience at Dress Rehearsal. All participants must attend Dress Rehearsal which will be **Monday, June 10 at 5PM.**

Each class will perform one dance and will need one costume. The Wednesday & Saturday beginner ballet, tap & jazz classes will perform 2 routines and therefore need 2 costumes. The costumes will cost approximately \$65; some may be slightly higher (usually the older dancers). The exact cost of each costume is not known at this time, however, **a \$65 non-refundable deposit per costume is due November 1-7.** Costumes will **not** be ordered unless deposits are received. Late costume orders can be placed however, the costume companies charge around \$20 for a "single order fee" and that would be an additional cost to you per costume. If you do NOT plan on being in the recital, we must know by November 1. Dancers not participating can still remain in class and learn the dance but would be placed in a spot that wouldn't affect the look of the choreography. After the holiday break, you will receive a statement with costume balances (if any) & tight costs (if any). Your costume balance will be due by February 1, 2019.

All students will be measured for costumes during class and sized according to the costume distributors' guidelines. Costumes used in the show are ready-made which the manufacturers make to order. It takes approximately 14 weeks to receive the costumes, which is why we will order the costumes before Thanksgiving. Since costumes are made to order, we must pay for them when ordered. The manufacturers will not accept any returns or cancellations. Therefore, **all sales (deposits and balances) are final (No refunds or credits) and we cannot cancel any orders once they are made. Upon receipt of your deposit we will consider you committed to doing BOTH recital days** (except for the Toddler Time & Pre Ballet classes who will do only one).

Just a few reminders:

- * The studio will be **OPEN** on November 10, Veterans Day.
- * Observation week is November 12 - 17.
- * The studio will be closed for the Thanksgiving Break from Wednesday, November 21 – Sunday, November 25.
- * The studio will be closed for the Holiday Break from December 23 – January 6. Classes will resume Monday, January 7, 2019.
- * **Inclement Weather:** In the case of inclement weather, please call the studio 1 hour prior to your class to see if your class will be held. If classes are cancelled the outgoing message will state that. Also, like us on FaceBook to get updates.
