

2024 Marysville Township Road Tour April 20th, 2024

Present: Joe Hickman, Andrew Hirsch, Bob Casey, and Debbie Uecker. Absent: William Uter and Ron Boehlke.

The road tour started at 11:30 am, roads looked at:

35th & Bolton intersection looks fine. Resident Aaron Roers at 3138 Bolton Ave is looking for 2 – 20ft culverts, band & apron, Bob Casey will follow up.

36th Street – washboards need to be cut out, southside of road needs to be brought in, need to spend extra time fixing this area all the way to Meridian. Use the groomer to pull the grass out of the clumps, use the CMP and cut more. Once cut put delineators on the curve.

Meridian – pull in shoulders on the Townline road; near 5336 Meridian pull the shoulders with the groomer & hit the sides with the CMP then use the grader to pull up the edges.

55th Street – cut edge of road.

Bolton – N of Co Rd 108, maintenance crew used the CMP 3 times on the road. The road looks good, need to use the groomer to run over it to pull weeds. Place a delineator by the rock to mark it.

5th Street – needs to have groomer run down it and pull the grass off. When the road dries, need to blade it.

Bolton – Culvert issue on Bolton, with the recent rain it sucked in part of the gravel road. We dumped gravel in to fill the hole. The culvert currently has a boiler tube in it. Bob & Andy will get a quote from Jake's Excavating & Brandon Mattson. Bob will ask Chatham to place delineators on Bolton.

2nd Street - needs to have a groomer run to pull the weeds.

Elder – needs to be pulled in more.

Estes – needs to have ditches sprayed, edges need to be cut in & sloped. 1920 Estes fix edge of road from the driveway to the South to re-slope the road.

25th Street – needs to be pulled in. 25th Street will have dust control applied from Co Rd 9 to the west side of the Marysville Cemetery to hold the hills together.

Devitt – pull ditches back so water will run off it.

Emerson & 35th intersection - need to run the CMP at the intersection, once completed then seed the intersection.

Erik – no changes.

20th Street – (West of Co Rd 8) run the CMP.

Drove by and looked at property 5826 1st Street.

Marysville Township currently has about 13,000 yards of gravel left in the pit.

The tour ended at 2:35pm.
