- All of the dry hydrants in town was discussed, all members agreed that we need to back flush them as well as some of them need to be painted and the brush cleared away from them a date to do this procedure is TBD.
- The EVOC class we discussed last month was talked about. We are looking at scheduling a class for the end of June or beginning of July depending on instructor availability.
- Squad 3 is to be lettered this week and 100% in service. This truck will be housed in District 3 (West Baldwin).
- Mandatory annual hose testing was scheduled for Saturday, June 6th at 7:00 a.m.
- Radio chatter and open mic's was discussed. We all agreed that members need to be more responsible and cautious with their radios and to not tie up an emergency frequency with non-emergency conversation.

The fire department was asked to assist with traffic control and parking cars. Nine (9) members have offered to help out that day.
