NOTICE OF CALL FOR BIDS

The Town of Upton, Wyoming is accepting sealed bids for the purchase and delivery of a pump station assembly to support irrigation at the Cedar Pines Golf Course.

Project Scope:

The Town is seeking qualified vendors to supply a complete pump station assembly, suitable for the irrigation need of a nine-hole golf course. This procurement includes the design, fabrication, and delivery of the pump system. Installation will be handled by the Town of Upton or a third-party contractor.

Scope of Supply:

The pump station assembly must include:

- Skid-mounted booster pump system
 - Pumps capable of delivering approximately 400–600 gallons per minute (GPM) at 80–120 PSI
 - Electrical motor (3-phase, 480V)
 - Control panel with Variable Frequency Drive (VFD)
 - Weatherproof outdoor-rated enclosure
 - System start-up and O&M manuals
 - Manufacturer's warranty (minimum 1 year)
