

MRS. ROBERT MORSE

Mrs. Wanda L. Morse, 87, Pigeon, died Wednesday at Huron Memorial Hospital, near Bad Axe, following a long illness.

Mrs. Morse was born Nov. 30, 1892, in Bay Port, daughter of the late Bertrand and Mary Baur.

She and Robert Morse were married Sept. 27, 1917, in Bay Port. He preceded her death June 11, 1978.

Mrs. Morse was a granddaughter of Emil Baur, founder of Ora LaBora, a 19th century settlement near Bay Port; a graduate of the Cincinnati Conservatory of Music; a great-niece of Clara Baur, who founded the conservatory; a charter member of the National Music Sorority Sigma Alpha Beta at the University of Cincinnati; a piano and voice instructor in Huron County;

a director of glee clubs and choirs at various churches throughout the county; a charter member of the Pigeon Senior Citizens Club; a charter member of the Scenic Golf Club, Pigeon, and a member of St. John's Episcopal Church, Sand Point.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Robert (Eleanor) Todd, Sparta, Mrs. William (Phyllis) Bolton, Sand Point, and Mrs. Robert (Joan) Gault, Garden City; two

sons, Robert Morse Jr., Palos Verdes Estates, Calif., and James Morse, Tucson, Ariz.; seven grandchildren; five step-grandchildren; one great-granddaughter, and three step-great-grandsons.

Six brothers and one sister preceded her in death.

Services will be 11 a.m. Saturday from St. John's Episcopal Church. Rev. James Sorenson will officiate. Burial will be in the Caseville Cemetery.
