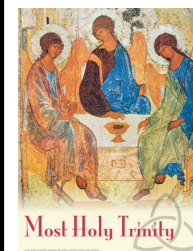

The Most Holy Trinity, June 11/12, 2022



THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

The Holy Trinity is a mystery and probably will never be understandable to the human mind. Yet the Holy Trinity is with us always but we are often unaware. While we cannot totally know or explain the Trinity we can acquaint ourselves with the roles of the Persons in the Holy Trinity for a better understanding of how they interact with our lives. The Father who elects Christians to salvation sent the Son into the world to be its Savior and the Holy Spirit to convert his elect and draw people to his Son. The Son redeemed his people by his death on the cross, and acts as the mediator between us and God. As our high priest the Son reveals the Father to us and sent the Holy Spirit into the world. The Holy Spirit acts as our teacher in the faith, bears witness to Jesus, sanctifies us and seals and protects us in the faith. In the beginning, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit were together, and were each involved in creating the world. In Jesus' life on earth, the Father and the Son worked together in unison and the Son was empowered by the Holy Spirit. The Father was in Christ reconciling the world to himself and the Son offered himself to the Father through the Holy Spirit for our salvation. Today, the Father and the Son make their home with us and the Holy Spirit makes us his temple in which he dwells. When we look at how these roles are each closely connected, and are used for the common purpose of our salvation, we can get a glimpse of the spender, the order and harmony between the Persons of the Trinity.

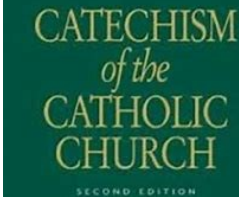

THE GRAVITY OF SIN: MORTAL AND VENIAL SIN

Sins are rightly evaluated according to their gravity. the distinction between mortal and venial sin, already evident in Scripture, became part of the tradition of the Church. It is corroborated by human experience.

Mortal sin destroys charity in the heart of man by a grave violation of God's law; it turns man away from God, who is his ultimate end and his beatitude, by preferring an inferior good to him.

Venial sin allows charity to subsist, even though it offends and wounds it.

Mortal sin, by attacking the vital principle within us - that is, charity - necessitates a new initiative of God's mercy and a conversion of heart which is normally accomplished within the setting of the sacrament of reconciliation:

When the will sets itself upon something that is of its nature incompatible with the charity that orients man toward his ultimate end, then the sin is mortal by its very object . . . whether it contradicts the love of God, such as blasphemy or perjury, or the love of neighbor, such as homicide or adultery.... But when the sinner's will is set upon something that of its nature involves a disorder, but is not opposed to the love of God and neighbor, such as thoughtless chatter or immoderate laughter and the like, such sins are venial.

For a sin to be mortal, three conditions must together be met: "Mortal sin is sin whose object is grave matter and which is also committed with full knowledge and deliberate consent."
