Trash to Treasure Theme



**"Framed Floral Masterpiece"**

The composition design must meet the following criteria:

1. Shape: A framed famous floral masterpiece work of art on an easel or plate stand (provided by designer)
2. Dimensions: 11 1/2" x 14" including frame (excluding easel)  
No larger than 14" W or 14" Deep  
Your table area to display will be 18" W
3. Weight: No more than 15 lbs.
4. Materials: Any type of recycled, reused or repurposed materials. No fresh plant material. Can use pods, cones, dried seed heads or any natural dried materials.
5. Each entrant must submit a 3 x 5 card:  
Front: Title and a list of the materials used  
Title of famous masterpiece and name of artist  
Back: District, Garden Club, Designer(s) name and mailing address.

ONLY ONE ENTRY FROM EACH DISTRICT

Entries must be submitted on Sunday, April 3, from 12-5 PM.  
Judging is at 5:15 PM.
