Donald Dalton, a native of Massachusetts, was born on the Fourth of July 1932.

At AFRTS as a Staff Sergeant he was assigned to AFKN in the early 1960's as station manager. He was married to the station's secretary, a Korean national named Kim, and the couple had two children. By the mid-1960's he was stationed in France.

In 1969, while serving with a combat unit in Vietnam, he was reassigned in mid-tour, as an SFC, to AFVN's Detachment 2 at Da Nang. Although he could handle on-air shifts, his skills did not actually rest in broadcasting. His talents were in admin; he was an orderly guy.

As a Master Sergeant, Don, who incidentally was called "Dizzy" by close friends, retired to Magna Township, Utah, a pleasant suburb of Salt Lake City. He passed away 20 June 1991, and is buried in the Utah State Veterans Cemetery, Riverton, Utah.
