We report it to the carrier yes. So if it increases then we as the Village pay it.

Mayor Wood:

Just to be clear, we are NOT annexing any private property.

How wide will this be?

Mayor Wood:

6 feet wide

Holly Roach:

Good. Now will there be anything to enforce people to walk on the sidewalk?

Samuel Weingarten:

If its there they will use it. No reason to have someone there to enforce it.

Mayor Wood:

Our time frame for the start of construction is Spring 2021

Holly Roach:

Whats happening with the old hardware store?

Mayor Wood:

The old hardware store is under construction.

Holly Roach:

The new synagogue by the firehouse on the corner. Whats going on with the parking? Its horrible and can cause an accident there

Mayor Wood:

The plans show it as a living room addition which is not for commercial use. So nothing can be done regarding parking at this time.

Holly Roach:

What is a synagogue listed for commercial use?

Alex Smith, Esq.:

No its religious use.

Holly Roach:

Well that's a big rabbit hole for anyone to use.

Eziel Fleishman:

Any news on water?

Mayor Wood:

Im going to let Tom talk regarding this.

Tom DePuy, Village Engineer:

Flow test was done this afternoon. Chlorine and flow test when everything is activated. Currently somethings are not activated.

Mayor Wood:

We are working slowly for this now especially now since the tax thing with Chestnut Ridge is costing the Village almost \$18,000.00

Holly Roach:

Rumor has it that the new condos on Winterton will be tapped into the water at Chestnut Ridge. Is that true?

Mayor Wood:

Yes it is true. It is right in the developers agreement

Holly Roach:

Oh ok. Well I will have to check my records

Eziel Fleishman:

I see that Winterton Road has been patched. Looks nice. Thank you

Mayor Wood:

Yes the Town of Mamakating did it.

Mayor Wood:

If that's all, motion to close the meeting
