Meeting of the DeKalb County Commission  
Commissioner's Room 9:00 A.M.

Present was Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison, East District Commissioner Garry McFee, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison and those in attendance said a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to approve the agenda for May 22, 2017 and to approve the minutes from the May 15<sup>th</sup> meeting with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. Motion carried.

Road & Bridge Supervisor Bill Gray met with the Commission to discuss Colfax Township needing a tube replaced. The Commission will go review.

An Aflac representative met with all staff to review their policies.

Collector/Treasurer Jessica Lee met with the Commission to discuss split not getting done and wanted to waive penalty and interest. Commission approved if paid by June 15<sup>th</sup>. Jessica also asked if she needed approval to paint and remodel her office. The Commission advised that they would just like to be made aware of any changes she does. The work will be paid for out of her Collector's Maintenance Fund.

Josh Johnson called about speed limit in Sanders Addition in Cameron. The Commission spoke with the Sheriff and at this time they are not changing any rules regarding speed limits on gravel roads.

Commission checked on lift for clock installation. Lift will come from Cameron Lumber.

Sheriff Andy Clark met with the Commission to discuss a dispatcher that was promoted to Deputy. He will be doing traffic during the Memorial Day Ceremony and that all deputies are reporting road signs missing.

David Brown of Dallas Township met with the Commission to discuss Liberty Road. He would like a portion of the road abandoned. The Commission advised him to contact other land owners about easements. Commission will seek legal advice on closing road permanently. He also had a question on bill the Township had received where a road had been turned dirt to gravel.

Johnnie Walker was in attendance with David Brown and took notes.

DeKalb County Prosecutor, Erik Tate and Victim's Advocate Joni Ignatenko met with the Commission to discuss the grant renewal and that they would need no additional monies from the County at this time.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn with East District Commissioner, Garry McFee making the second. Motion carried.
