Health Safety / Zachor / Purim

We look forward to an exciting and safe Purim at Keter Torah.

- Local health authorities recommend not cancelling events or activities. We will make necessary adjustments to building, programs and food serving as recommended by health professionals.
- If you are sick with a fever and/or respiratory illness, you must not come to Shul, even if you have a chiyuv, want to say kaddish, or hear Zachor or megillah. Please contact Rabbi Baum directly for alternative ways to fulfill these obligations.
- Anyone who has recently traveled to China, South Korea, Japan, Italy, or any of the other countries identified by the [CDC](https://www.cdc.gov) should not come to Shul for the foreseeable future, and until discussed with the staff at the Shul.
- Don't share Purim masks with others.
- Avoid shaking hands when greeting friends in Shul.
- The tradition of Machatzit Hashekel coins will not be available at Shul this year. You can set aside additional tzedakah at home to satisfy this practice.
- Please make out checks for **Matanot L'Evyonim** to the Keter Torah Charity Fund or visit www.keter Torah.org and select *Matanot L'Evyonim* from the PayPal drop-down menu. These funds are distributed during the day on Purim.
- Consider an additional contribution to the Charity Fund for the yearlong needs of fellow members.
- Mishloach Manot is not sent to mourners, but can be sent to their family members.
- Mourners should send Mishloach Manot to one non-family member.
