SECTION 1.0
STATUTORY AUTHORIZATION

§ 1.1 Village Law §3-300 authorizes the board of trustees of a village with a population of less than three thousand to provide, in lieu of any other residency requirement imposed by law, that the village justice may reside within the county in which the village is wholly or partially situate.

SECTION 2.0
RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR OFFICE OF VILLAGE JUSTICE

§ 2.1 No person shall be eligible to hold the office of Village Justice of Cohocton, New York unless said person shall be a resident of Steuben County, New York.

SECTION 3.0
EFFECTIVE DATE

§ 3.1 This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
