LENTEN JOURNEY

Then Jesus called the twelve together and gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases, ² and he sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal the sick. ³ He said to them, "Take nothing for your journey: no staff, nor bag, nor bread,

nor money—not even an extra tunic. Luke 9:1-3

In our daily lives, we often find ourselves overpacking. Perhaps you have packed for a week-long vacation, a weekend trip, or maybe just an overnight business trip. It appears each of these types of trips result in me packing many of the same essentials. What's one more, or even two more, sets of clothing when you have planned to be away just one night?

Yet when Jesus sent the twelve disciples out, he gave them all they needed to have a successful discipleship trip. What? No makeup, hairdryer, hair straightener, 3 oz of approved liquids, no snacks? Note that in these verses, Jesus tells us to not take a walking stick, suitcase, or snacks – or even money – and certainly not that third "light weight jacket" that we are accustomed to packing for those cool nights.

As we prepare for this 2025 Lenten journey, what is it that is excess baggage for you? I don't mean things that fit in a suitcase, but rather, things that fit into your very being – your soul? Things like stress, anxiety, fears, assumptions, etc. How heavy are those for you? How easy are those for God?

Jesus often uses the image of bread in scriptures. During this 2025 Wednesday Lenten Journey, we will focus on bread. We will begin on Ash Wednesday as Jesus stands up in the temptation story to respond, "Not by bread alone." We will journey through bread images all the way to Easter Morning – when we celebrate a Bread for Feasting.

Welcome and travel along with us as we head through the wheat and yeast this Lenten journey. Each Wednesday evening, we invite you to join us for:

- 6:00 PM: Simple Soup & Bread Supper in the Fellowship Hall
- 7:00 PM: Lenten Worship Service

Together, we'll explore how bread nourishes not just our bodies, but our spirits as well, and discover what it means to travel lightly with Christ.


SUPPORT TEAM HAPPENINGS




