

SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT & EDUCATION PROGRAM

SEEd is a voluntary program designed to help motivated young adults seek mainstream jobs and further their education, by working with qualified, supportive staff. Using the Individual Placement and Support Model (IPS), our team will guide young people toward reaching their employment and education goals.

TARGETED POPULATION

- ✓ Individuals who want to go to school or find employment
- Enrolled in CCS
- ✓ Young adults between 16-24 years of age

MEMBER ENGAGEMENT

- Contact with the young adult is made within 24 hours of receiving a referral
- ✓ Job search and/or educational placement preparation begins in the first 30 days
- Regular contact with the young adult is made in the community, at the job site, or at the educational institution, designed to fit the needs of the member

A young adult who desires to go to work or enroll in educational programming





RESOURCES

- SEEd team members work in the community to meet young adults where they are
- SEEd staff are located inside of Owen's Place, a drop-in resource center serving this population
- ✓ The SEEd team is made up of several qualified professionals, including:
 - Supported Employment Specialists
 - Supported Education Specialists
 - Peer Coach
- ✓ The SEEd team works closely with IPS teams throughout Milwaukee County and the state of Wisconsin to enhance IPS service model delivery.

ACTIVITIES

- ✓ **SEEd** program uses IPS model in service delivery
- ✓ Educational or employment assessment starts within the first 30 days of enrollment
- Enrollment and follow along supports are time unlimited
- ✓ SEEd staff must participate in scheduled monthly team meetings
