

## Robert Chesney Succumbs To Heart Attack *May 23* *1946*

Robert Chesney, died suddenly from a heart attack which he suffered while working in the crusher at the Quarry Monday, May 20th, at two o'clock in the afternoon, at the age of 62 years. He had been in poor health the past few years. He was the son of Sarah M. Packer and Henry Chesney, born to them on May 16th, 1884 in Oxford County, Canada, and came to the United States in October 1895. He made his home in Huron county since that time, and when 18 years old he came to the Quarry and has worked most of his life for the Wallace Stone Co. Thirty-one years ago he was united in marriage to Mrs. Nellie Davidson. He leaves to mourn his loss, his widow, one son, Henry Chesney of Millington, one step-daughter, Mrs. William Eden of Bay Port, one step son, George Davidson, of Mayville; seven brothers, Joseph and James Chesney of Port Huron, George Chesney of Detroit, Andrew Chesney of Inkster, William and Albert Chesney of Port Austin, and Henry Chesney, residence unknown; two sisters, Mrs. Harriet Fleming of Port Huron, and Mrs. Jane Becker of Bad Axe, and a host of friends. The funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at two o'clock in the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. Elder Archie Harder officiated. Burial was in the New Bay Port Cemetery.
