Honoring 50 Years of Service Through Scholarship

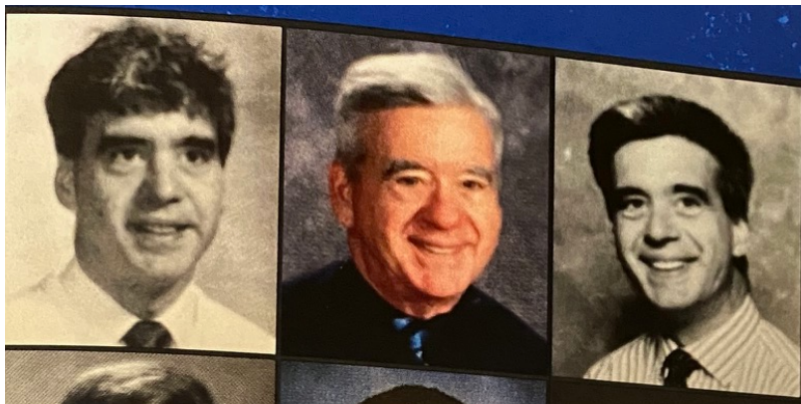

Sick Bank Update

Two contracts ago we negotiated and established a sick bank for WGTA members. This benefit was created as 90 day gap coverage for major medical situations and provides paid sick days for members between used contractual sick days and disability insurance. Several of our members have benefitted from this option.

When we initiated this benefit eight years ago all participating members were required to donate 2 contractual sick days to the sick bank. In addition, new members participating in the sick bank benefit have donated two contractual sick days. We are quickly reaching the end of the available donated days and need to plan on restoring the sick bank.

Next school year, all members wishing to stay with the sick bank option will be required to donate two additional sick days. If you're a participant in the sick bank and would like to continue you don't have to do anything. Your two sick days will be deducted at the start of the school year. If you want to opt out, you will be required to contact the district office requesting to be removed from the sick bank. If you're not a participant of the WGTA sick bank and want to participate in this free insurance click on the link below, complete the form and send it to the district office department of business prior to October 5th 2023.
