DESCRIPTION: The Yukon X-24 is a great starter bow. And like all Shakespeare's, it shoots as well as high end bows. Maple riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Tip overlays have been added to beautify and strengthen the tips. No drilled holes; there is a factory installed stabilizer bushing that is capped with a black screw. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a new string.
