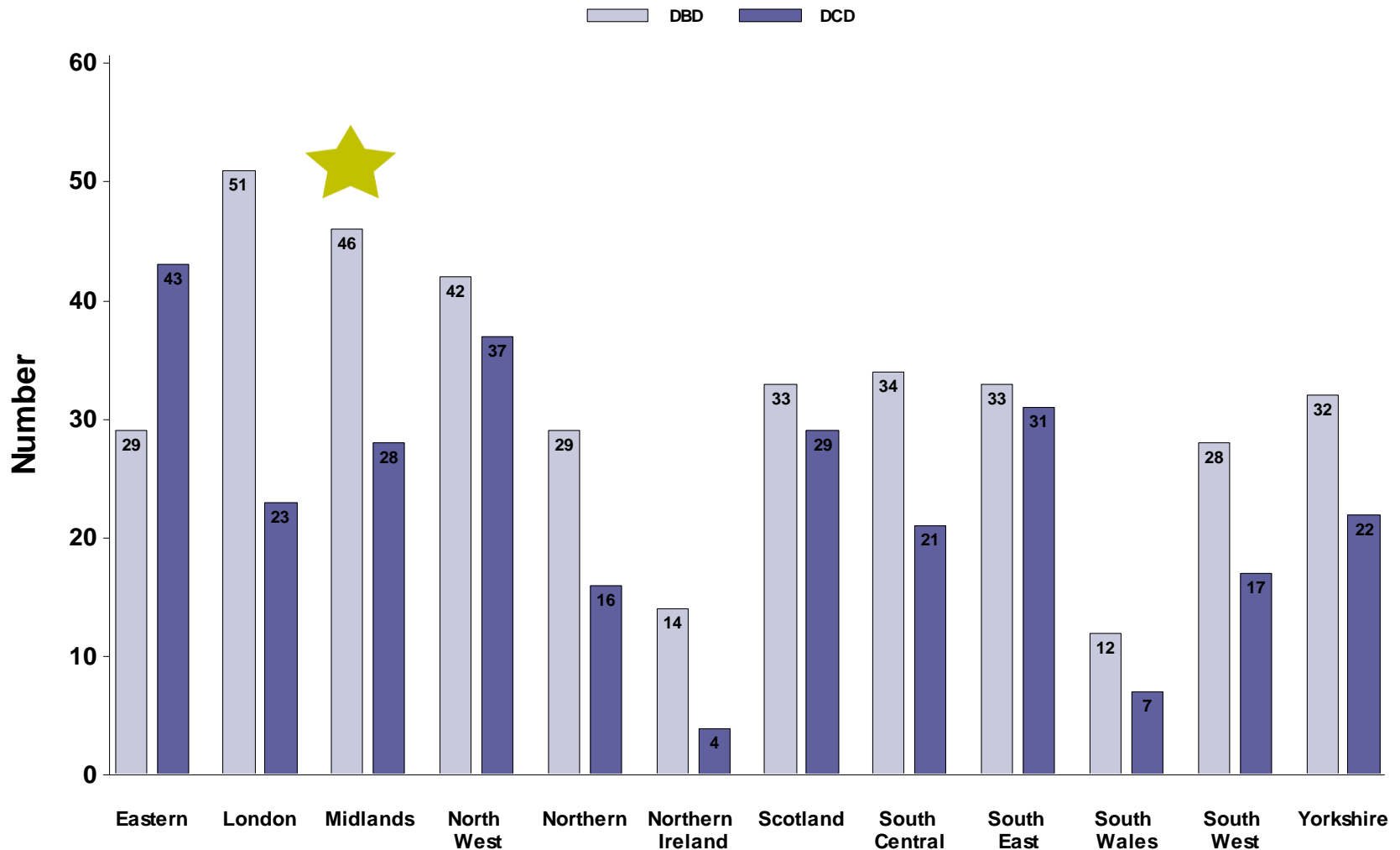

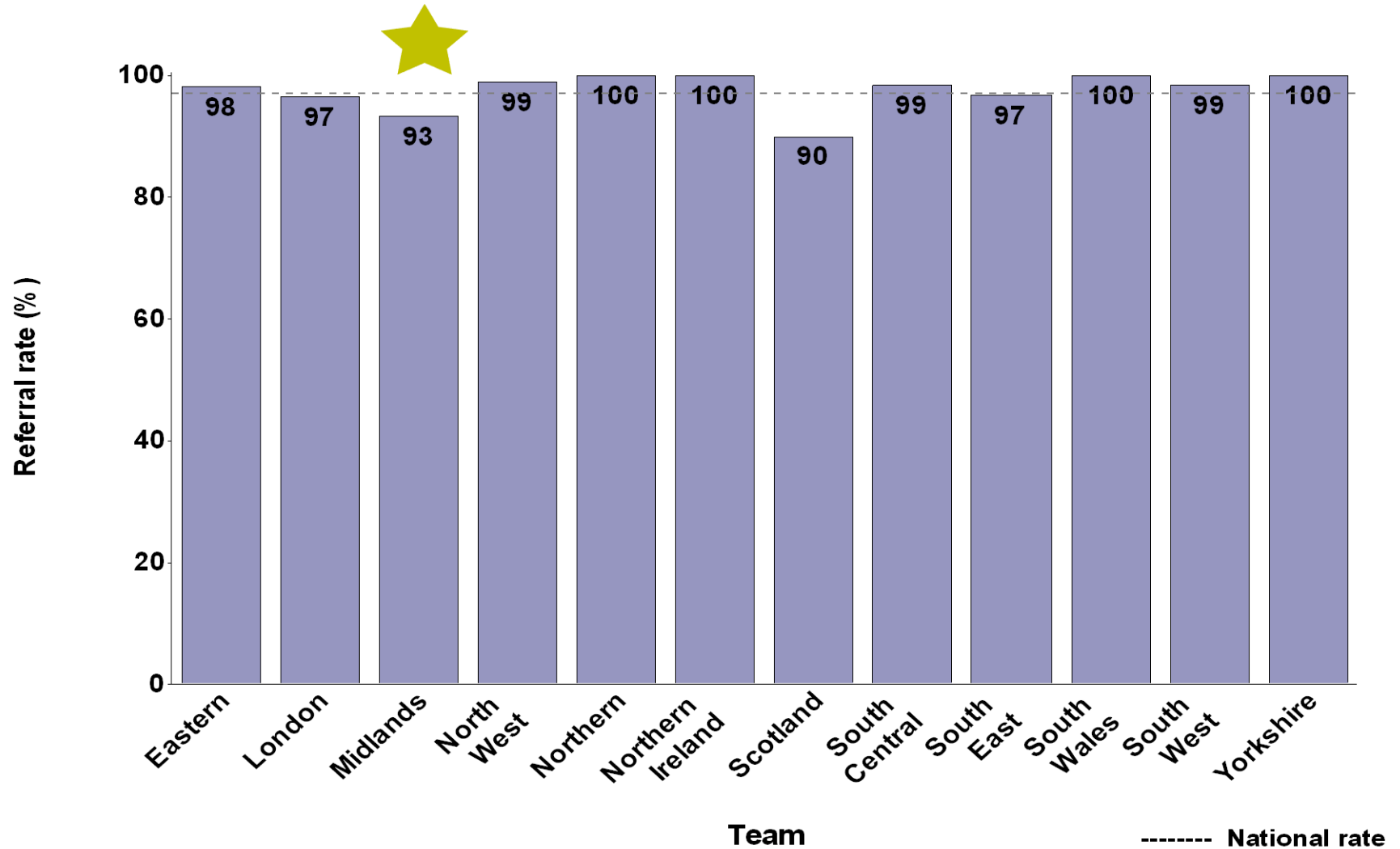

# Actual deceased donors



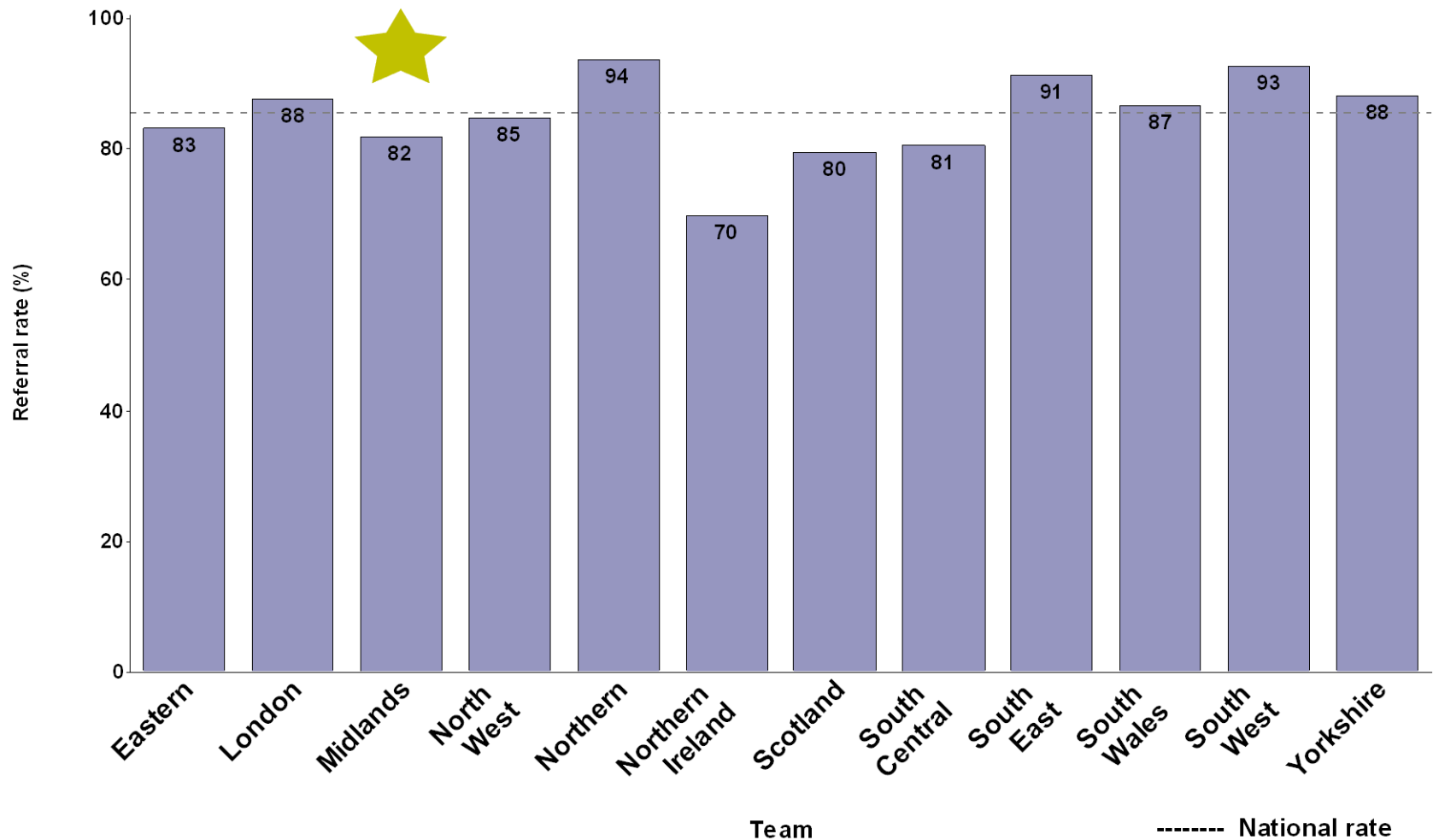

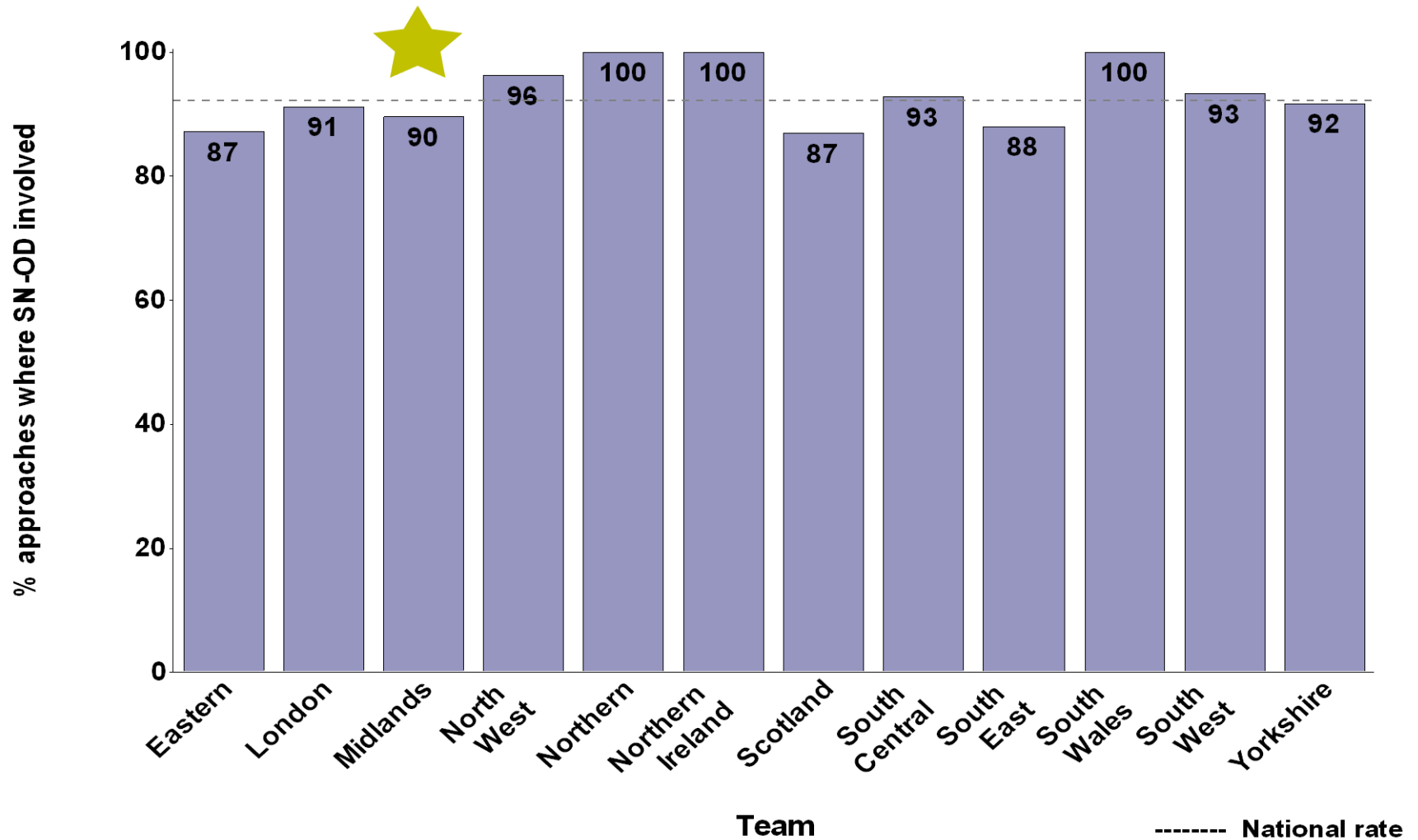
# DCD referral rate

# DBD SNOD involved

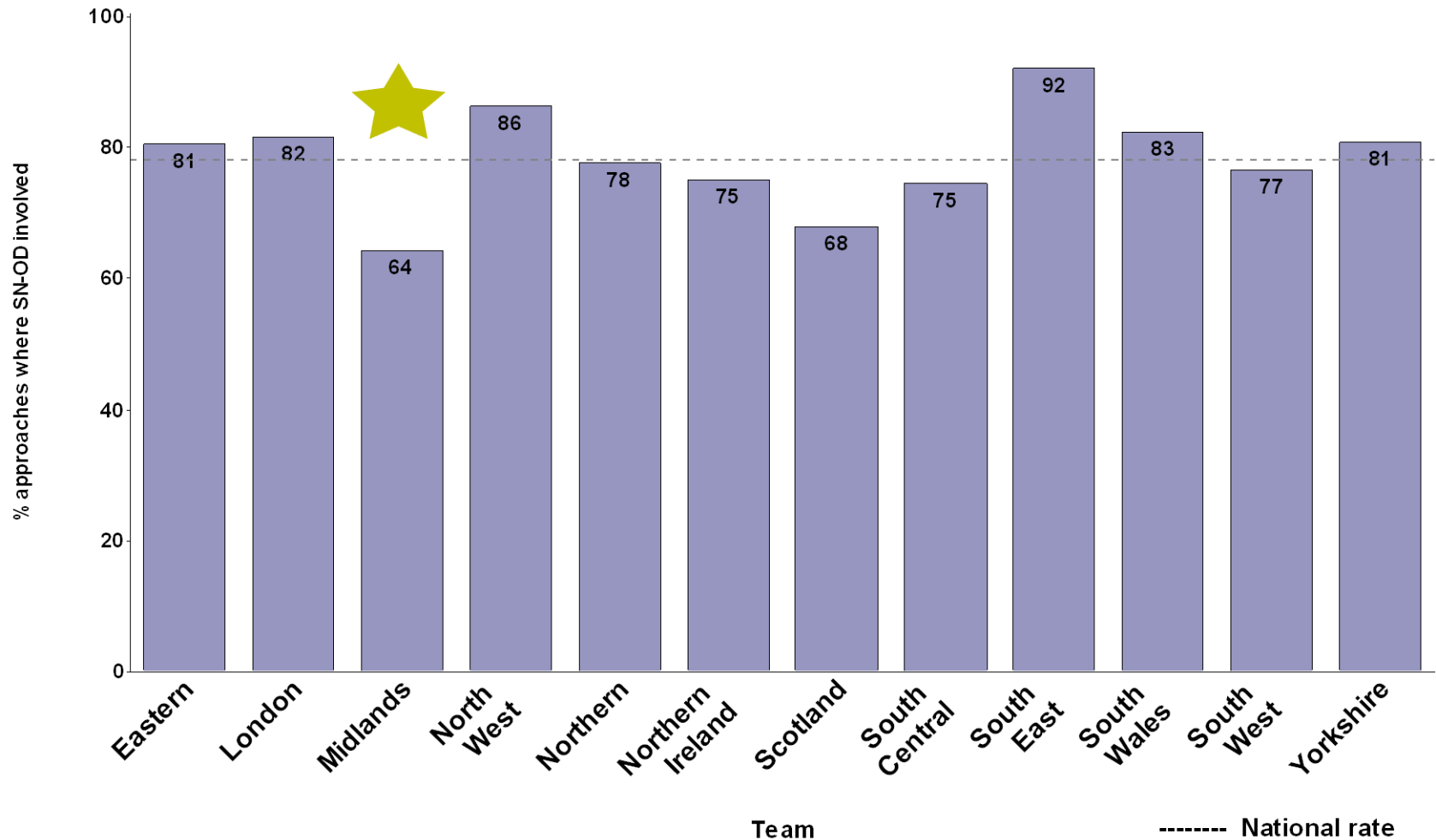
Midlands Consent Rate 65%

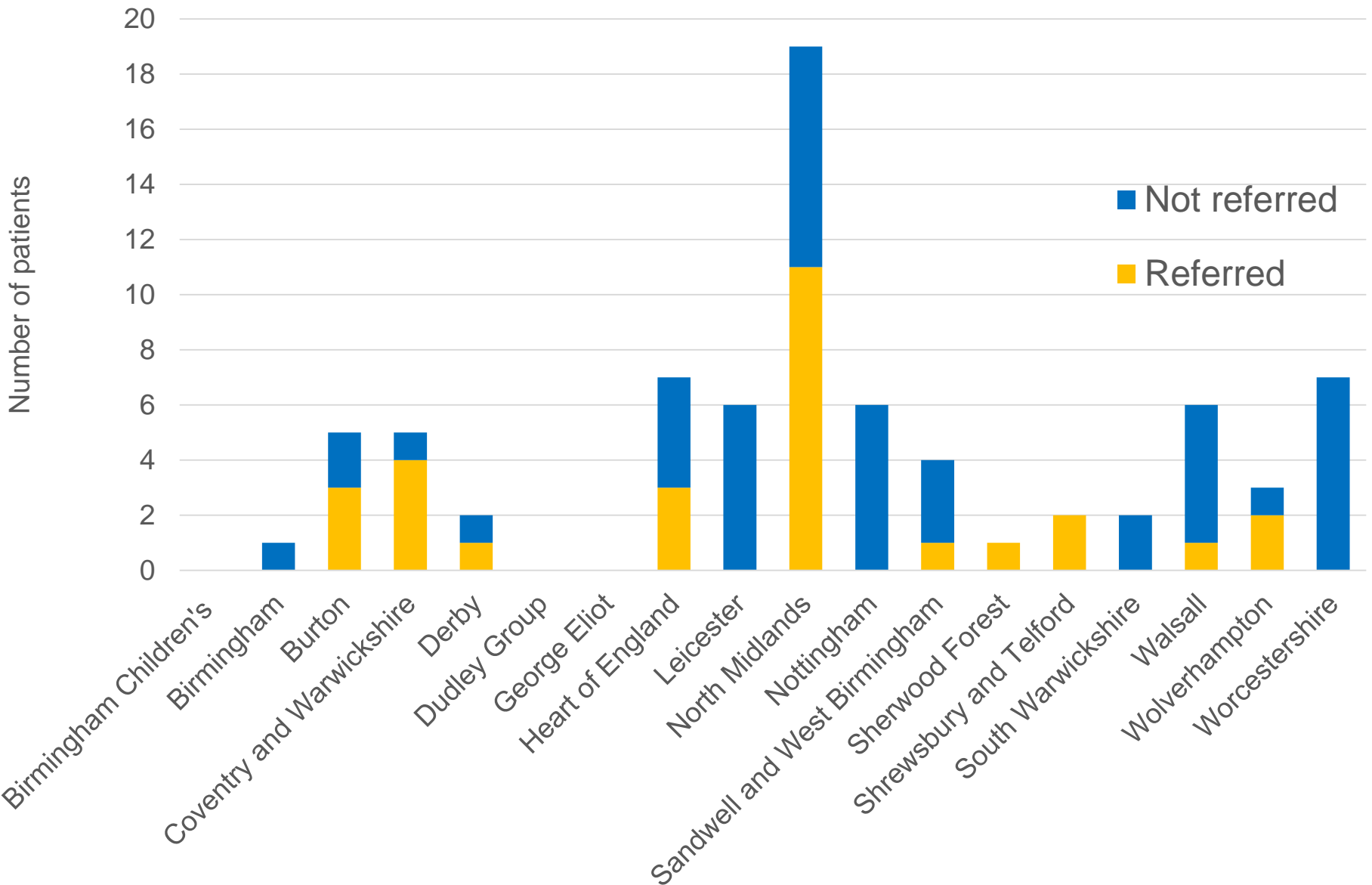
Midlands Consent Rate 51%

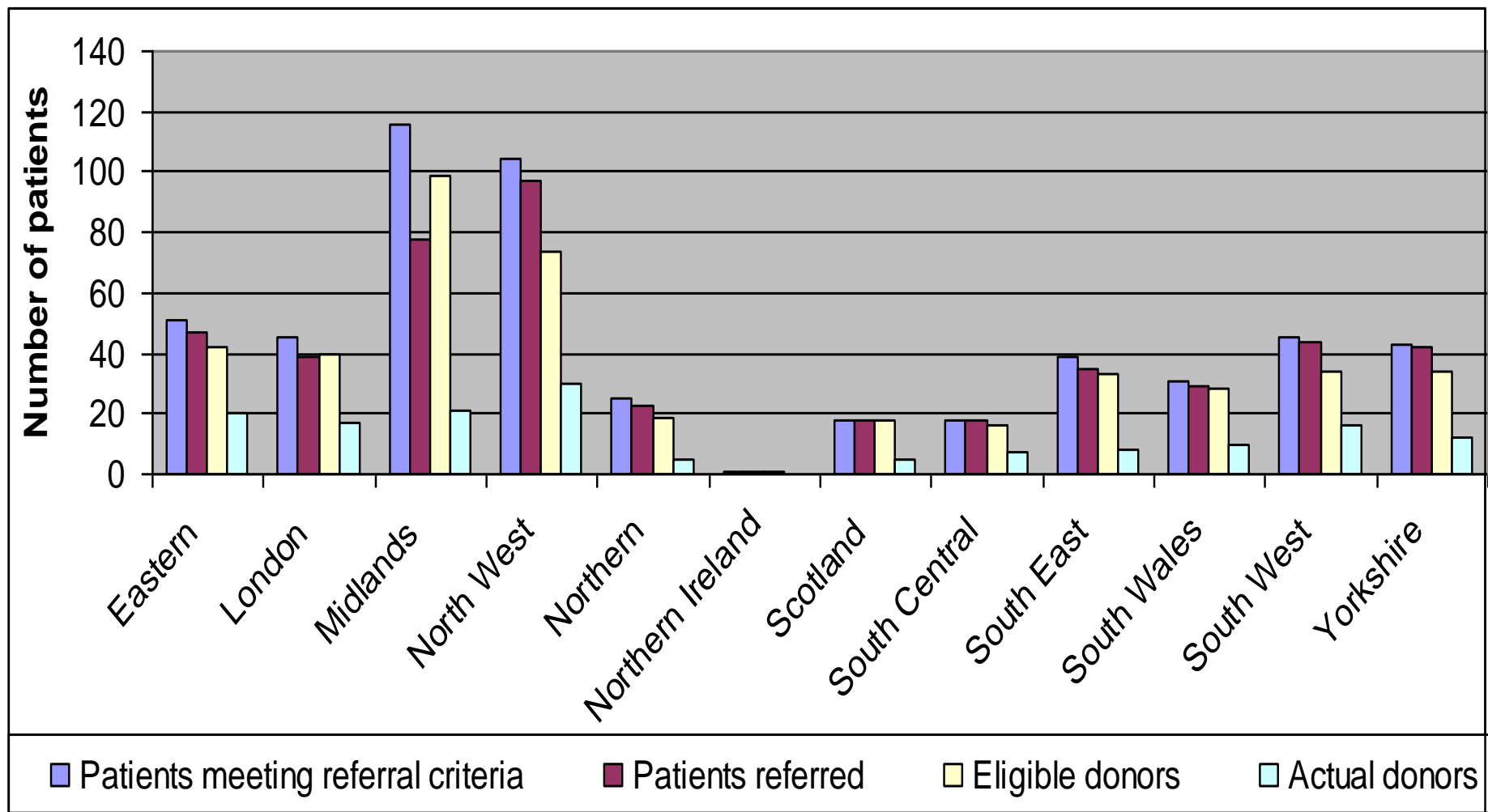


# Died in Emergency Department meeting referral criteria, by Trust April 2016 to September 2016
