A selected destination will be picked each year, mostly in the southern hemisphere (i.e. Australia, New Zealand, Asia, South Africa).

3. Dues - Dues are \$200 per year to be paid annually on March 1. If a member joins after March 1, dues will be prorated at the sum of \$20.00 per month for the remainder of the year. Dues are used to defray the club's operational costs: boat rental, pfd's, paddles, insurance, etc. Please make checks payable to Space Coast Dragon Boat Club (SCDBC).

4. Season - A ten-month season is planned (November 15th – January 15th off). Once the various crews have been formed and are underway, each crew will determine its practice schedule, its competitive schedule and the length of its season.

5. Practices - Practices are held on Wednesday and Sunday evenings at 6:00 PM. An exercise routine will begin promptly at 6:15 p.m. followed by departing the dock at Oars and Paddles Park at 6:30 p.m. Practice times may have to be changed due to time change from Daylight Savings Time.
