Grounds and General Information – Trial will be outdoors on grass. Grounds open at 7am and close at 10pm. Electricity is available throughout the fairgrounds with preference given to overnight RV accommodations.

DIRECTIONS;

From North: Take Hwy 99 South to Turlock. Exit Fulkerth, turn left (eastbound). The third stop light will be Golden State. Make a right on Golden State and then an immediate right on to North Front. Go approximately 2 blocks and make a right, cross the RR tracks, right on Broadway and enter through gate next to the Fairgrounds Office.

From South: Take Hwy 99 North to Turlock. Exit Fulkerth, turn right (eastbound). Follow above directions.

From the Bay Area: Hwy 580 to 205 East towards Tracy/Stockton. Take I5 North and merge onto CA 120 towards Manteca/Sonora. Exit at Hwy 99 South (Modesto) and continue to Turlock.
