### Leaf Pick Up

The maintenance department will start picking up leaves on Monday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> and continue thru the first week of December, weather permitting. Leaves must be raked to the edge of the street and free of animal waste, garbage, stones and sticks. Please note brush and bagged leaves will not be accepted. You can also continue to drop brush off behind the Village barn, 66 Maple Ave anytime throughout the year. PLEASE DROP ITEMS OFF IN DESIGNATED AREAS, NO GARBAGE. Also, remember per village law you are responsible for keeping your sidewalk free of snow & ice. The village does plow the sidewalks as a courtesy when available.
