## **OLD BUSINESS**

<u>Road Report</u> – No funding for Colony Road Cul-du-sac this year from the state. The County plans to apply for the Colony RD grant again next year. Kinley Rd. will not become a class A road due to the fact it does not have a direct destination as of now. Talks are going on with various entities on the improvement of Kinley Rd.

High Grade Company will be making an onsite road with an outlet on Colony, they will not be using Gilson RD, and this is for their mining site on the corner of Colony and Gilson.

MDOT and Supervisor Thelen are discussing left turn lanes on 27 from the ramp to Gratiot County Line Rd.

Maple Rapids Rd. will be resurfaced from Welling Rd to Maple Rapids; this is a road commission expense.

Road Commission and our Township Representatives; Trustee Graham, Trustee Kindel, and Supervisor Thelen will meet March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019 for this year road work to be done in the township. Such as where does the township want to put gravel, chip seal, etc.

<u>Budget 2019-2020</u> - Discussed some accounts from current budget that needed additions to balance before the new budget can be approved. The Board gave Treasurer Roof permission to adjust and bring to next month's meeting the updated balanced 2018-2019 budget and also the 2019-2020 Budget. Motion by Roof seconded by Kindel motion carried.
