

Trail Treasure Hunt

Ride or hike the designated trail in search of “treasure” that looks like this. Find ONE – turn it in for a prize!



Note: Discs all have hot pink paint on one side and sponsor name and number on other. They are approximately 3 ½ inches in diameter.

- The “treasure” may be on the ground or in the crook of a tree or under a rock but will be at least partially visible from the trail. Stay on the trail until you spot one.
- Treasures will be hidden periodically throughout the 2-week span, so no need to rush out right away on Sept 1.
- **Retrieve only 1 “treasure” per person.** If you spot more, please leave them for others.
- **If you find a treasure, take a selfie with it (make sure number is visible) near its location.** Send the photo to govdodgephotos@gmail.com with “Treasure” in the subject line. Include your name and contact information in the email.
- **Deposit the “treasure” in the white bucket** under the sign in the FIREWOOD shed near the park office on your way out of the park.
- When we have your recovered “treasure” and the selfie with contact information, your prize will be mailed to you! Prizes range from coupons for free food to gift cards from local merchants.

Nature Photo Hunt

Ride or Hike the designated trail in search of photo ops in 6 categories. \$50 cash prize - each category!



Note: The image must feature or reflect the presence of items at Governor Dodge State Park and must be photographed by the Applicant during the period running September 1-13.

- Only 1 entry per category per person
- Photos should be clear and engaging. Judges will be looking for accuracy, clarity, perspective, and humor or creativity.
- **Each photo should be emailed separately to govdodgephotos@gmail.com**
- **Participants’ name and photo category should be in the subject line of each photo email. Send separately!**
- **Applicant’s contact information should be in body of email**
- Photos should be submitted in jpeg format not to exceed 1200 by 800 pixels.
- Photos must be received no later than Sunday, September 13 at 11pm
