Florida St QB Tommy Castellanos led the Seminoles to a shocking 31-17 upset of No. 8 Alabama. FSU was a 13.5-point underdog and were +425 on the money-line. Castellanos made headlines this summer when he said, "They don't have Nick Saban to save them." He was correct.

Misleading Finals

South Florida (+4.5) upset Boise State 34-7. We're not saying USF wasn't the right side and didn't deserve to win the game. However, Boise State did have a 378-372 yard edge but were -3 in turnovers. Plus, the Broncos got stopped on downs in USF territory on three separate occasions. USF got a long fake punt TD as well.

Minnesota (-16.5) probably should have covered vs Buffalo. The Gophers had a dominating 443-151 yard edge which usually equates to a 3-TD plus win.

Central Michigan (+14) upset San Jose State 16-14. Again, we're not saying CMU wasn't the right side. However, San Jose did have a 383-340 yard edge and were -3 in TO's while also missing a FG late that would have given them the win.

Georgia Tech (-3.5) beat Colorado 27-20. It should have been worse if not for three turnovers in the first quarter for GT. The Jackets had 320 yards rushing.

Tarleton State (+14) upset Army 30-27 in 2OT. Again, Tarleton was the right side but Army should have won the game. Army led 24-10 in the second half but had a complete meltdown with three turnovers and two missed FG's.

Maryland (-13) beat Florida Atlantic 39-7. However, the Terps benefited from a +6 turnover margin and only had a 380-354 yard edge.

Arizona (-15.5) beat Hawaii 40-6. However, the Wildcats were +5 in turnovers and only outgained Hawaii 346-293.

Liberty (-25.5) beat Maine 28-7. Liberty outscored Maine 21-0 in the fourth quarter and were +2 in turnovers. Liberty only had a 391-316 yard edge.

SMU (-50.5) beat East Texas A&M 42-13. SMU only had a 400-351 yard edge in the game. SMU got a pair of "Pick 6's" including a 95-yarder. East Texas A&M also fumbled at the SMU 4-yard line.

Louisiana Tech (-14.5) beat SE Louisiana 24-0. However, Louisiana Tech was outgained 273-262. The Bulldogs were +3 in turnovers.

South Carolina (-6.5) beat Virginia Tech 24-11. However, VT had a 336-334 yard edge. The Hokies were -2 in turnovers and gave up a long punt return TD.

Bad Beats

Michigan State (-21.5) led Western Michigan 23-0 late in the fourth quarter and were inside the red zone looking to score again. The Spartans fumbled. On their next drive, their backup QB threw a "Pick 6" with under 2 minutes left for the 23-6 final.

UL-Monroe (-30.5) missed two extra points in their 29-0 win over FCS St. Francis (PA). ULM also dropped a wide open TD pass in the closing minute. Early ULM backers did cash as the line opened ULM -23.5.

The total in the Northern Arizona/Arizona State game was 52.5. Northern Arizona scored a TD with :20 left to put the game OVER in their 38-19 loss.

The total in the Nevada/Penn State game was 54.5 and Penn State closed as a 42.5-point favorite (opened 44.5). Nevada was trailing 46-3 late but scored a TD with :25 left that put the game over and also got their late backers a cover.

Texas Tech (-54.5) and OVER 62.5 backers were dealt a blow due to a technicality. Texas Tech won 67-7 but the second half of the game (after a lengthy weather delay) was shortened to a pair of 8 minute quarters. Most sports books state that 55 minutes must be played in a game for their to be action.

Texas A&M (-23.5) led UTSA 42-17 late in the fourth quarter. UTSA with their backup QB converted a 4th & 7 in the final minute and then got a 34-yard TD pass with :14 left for the back door.

Injuries/Personnel News

-Hawaii QB Micah Alejado (foot) will be a game-time decision vs Sam Houston State. The market has bet Sam Houston from +11 to +6.5.

-Wisconsin QB Billy Edwards (lower body) is not expected to play vs Middle Tennessee. Danny O'Neill will likely get the start.

-Army QB Dewayne Coleman is expected to play vs Kansas State.

-Clemson WR Antonio Williams (hamstring) did not practice on Monday.

-Texas Tech QB Behren Morton is dealing with some muscle soreness around his shin but his X-rays and MRI's came back negative.

-Liberty backup QB Ryan Burger will medically retire from football due to concussions.

-Virginia QB Chandler Morris (shoulder) has been upgraded to available to play vs NC State.

-Alabama WR Ryan Williams (concussion) is questionable to play vs UL-Monroe.

-Oklahoma State QB Hauss Hejny (foot) who started the opener is out indefinitely.

-Missouri starting kicker Blake Craig will miss the rest of the season. QB Sam Horn is out indefinitely with a leg injury.

-Michigan LB Jaishawn Barham will miss the first half vs Oklahoma after a targeting call vs New Mexico.

-North Carolina QB Gio Lopez left the TCU game with a back injury. Max Johnson came into the game and gave the NC offense some life in the pass game.

Games in Rotation Order

Friday, September 5th

LOUISVILLE 36 James Madison 21. Both teams are coming off comfortable wins over FCS schools last week. JMU had a 313-64 rushing yard edge vs Weber State while Louisville outgained Eastern Kentucky 542-150. We thought the opener was a really good number but we've seen a lot of support for JMU. We like Louisville at -13.5.

MARYLAND 32 Northern Illinois 16. Maryland easily won and covered vs FAU last week but the Terps were +6 in turnovers. NIU nearly lost to Holy Cross as their new offense was a no-show. Our ratings lean NIU here but these are usually the type of games Maryland HC Locksley takes care of business.

Saturday, September 6th

PENN STATE 49 Florida International 7. Penn State led Nevada 46-3 but gave up a TD in the final seconds that cost some of their backers. Head coach James Franklin tends to "know" the point-spread and wasn't too pleased in the immediate post-game on the field interview. FIU won and covered in their debut of HC Willie Simmons. Our ratings like Penn State and OVER.

TEXAS TECH 53 Kent State 8. If you bet Texas Tech and OVER last week, you suffered a bad beat due to a shortened game (see page 1). More importantly for Tech is their QB Morton is once again banged up and might not play here. Meanwhile, Kent State broke their 21-game losing streak last week but needed a 100-yard kick return TD late to do it over Merrimack (average FCS team). We lean dog and OVER.

NC STATE 29 Virginia 26. An important game for both teams as far as meeting preseason expectations (both had win totals of 6.5). We definitely were more impressed with UVA in the opener as they hammered Coastal Carolina 48-7 as 13.5-point favorites. Meanwhile, NC State after leading East Carolina 24-7 were out-played for much of the second half in their 24-17 win. We wanted to bet UVA in the game but needed a "+3.5" or more.

TEXAS 45 San Jose State 10. Both teams had disappointing openers. San Jose State lost outright as a 2-TD favorite to Central Michigan and Texas lost at Ohio State where their offense managed just 7 points. Both teams were better in the box score than the scoreboard. We expect Texas to want get Arch Manning some confidence and like OVER here as San Jose State ran some tempo last week (No. 12).

Liberty 27 JACKSONVILLE STATE 23. We were not impressed with Liberty last week as they entered the 4Q tied 7-7 with Maine. The market has hated Jacksonville State all off-season and also in Week 1. They were wrong so far as Gamecocks nearly upset UCF as 3-TD underdogs. We bet Jacksonville St on the opener. A sharp group came in on the UNDER yesterday.

PITTSBURGH 38 Central Michigan 14. CMU made a big splash in the debut of HC Matt Drinkall as they upset San Jose St 16-14 as 2-TD underdogs. We were impressed with their rushing attack but they were +3 in turnovers. Pitt is off a 61-9 win over Duquesne and we'll find out more about them here. Our ratings like Pitt and so far the early week market agrees.

IOWA STATE 22 Iowa 19. The Cy-Hawk Trophy went to Iowa State last year but Iowa has won their last six trips to Ames. The Cyclones are 2-0 and have been super impressive with an upset of Kansas State and a dominating win over FCS South Dakota (55-7 as 16-point favorites). Iowa was pedestrian in their win over 34-7 win over Albany laying 39.5 points. We bet Iowa +3.5 but will pass at current.

SYRACUSE 33 Connecticut 26. Syracuse was out-classed by Tennessee last week in a 45-26 loss (+13.5). Connecticut destroyed FCS Central Connecticut 59-13 (-28.5). These two just played here in November with Syracuse winning 31-24 (-10.5). UConn is a little better than last year and Syracuse has taken a step back. So far the money has been on UConn this week. We'd actually lean Syracuse at current.

SMU 32 Baylor 31. Really important game for both. Baylor enters 0-1 as they were dominated at the line of scrimmage by Auburn (out-rushed 307-64). Quietly, SMU had one of the least impressive performances of any team in Week 1. They beat East Texas A&M 42-13 as 50.5-point favorites but got a pair of "Pick 6's" in the game. The early week money has been all over Baylor here and we agree.

Illinois 26 DUKE 23. One of the more intriguing non-conference matchups. Illinois has a lot of preseason hype and this game will give us an idea of how good they can be. Both had easy wins over FCS teams last week although Duke struggled early vs Elon. New Duke QB Mensah did look good completing 27 of 34 for 389 yards and 3 TD's. We bet a little Illinois early at -1.5 but at the current prices, we're sitting on the sidelines.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

INDIANA 45 Kennesaw State 10. We bet OVER 50.5 and a sharp group also took the OVER. It's a sneaky one as both teams had low scoring week one games. However, Indiana only scored 20 points on six trips inside Old Dominion's 10-yard line (you'd normally expect 30-plus in that scenario). Kennesaw only scored 9 points at Wake Forest but ran the second fastest tempo in the country last week.

TEXAS A&M 44 Utah State 10. Texas A&M wasn't that impressive in week one as they got out-rushed 203-110 by UTSA. Still, the Aggies led 42-17 before allowing a 34-yard TD pass with :14 left that left their backers stunned. Utah State got a nice debut win for new head coach Bronco Mendenhall. Our ratings like Texas A&M here and so far the market agrees. Is A&M looking ahead to Notre Dame next week?

Ole Miss 30 KENTUCKY 19. Ole Miss is playing with revenge after Kentucky beat them 20-17 as 15-point underdogs last year. The Rebels destroyed Georgia State 63-7 in the opener including a 38-0 run in the second half. Meanwhile, Kentucky won a hard-fought 24-16 game over Toledo as 10-point favorites. We bet Ole Miss at -9.5 and also lean with the UNDER.

MISSOURI 30 Kansas 24. The Border War saw these two play each other 120 times but they haven't met since 2011 (damn you conference realignment). Kansas comes in at 2-0 and the Jayhawks have been impressive in both games. Missouri is 1-0 and easily dispatched an FCS opponent last week as QB Pribula was 23 of 28 for 283 yards. We lean with the OVER at current.

NAVY 40 Uab 20. UAB trailed FCS Alabama State 28-17 in the third quarter last week and we were wondering if HC Trent Dilfer would make it to this game. UAB rallied for a 52-42 win but allowed 514 yards. That's not good news vs a Navy offense that ran for 464 yards last week. No surprise the early week money is on Navy.

North Texas 34 WESTERN MICHIGAN 24. Keep an eye on this North Texas team. We bet OVER 6.5 wins and also bet them to win the AAC as a long-shot. The market liked them last week and they won 51-0. This is a much improved defense with a new DC and several Sam Houston transfers. Western Michigan meanwhile got a back-door cover vs Michigan State thanks to a "Pick 6". Early week money is on North Texas. We lean UNDER at current.

OREGON STATE 26 Fresno State 23. What a second half by Fresno State last week. The Bulldogs were out-classed by Kansas in the opener and then were trailing Georgia Southern 14-10. They outscored Georgia Southern 32-0 in the second half and had a 351-84 rushing yard edge. Oregon State stood on shot vs Cal true frosh QB Sagapolutele. Early week money is on Oregon St. We're passing.

CLEMSON 42 Troy 10. We thought LSU beat Clemson much worse than the final last week. We graded that game more like 24-10 or 27-10. That's pretty alarming for a Clemson team at home and with the most experienced roster in CFB. They should have no trouble here vs a Troy team that outscored Nicholls State 28-3 in the 4Q of a 38-20 win. However, Clemson did not look like a title contender.

RUTGERS 30 Miami, OH 15. We were not impressed with Rutgers last week as their defense could not stop Ohio QB Parker Navarro who accounted for more than 300 yards. Now the Scarlet Knights face another MAC team in Miami, OH. The Redhawks are far less likely to have the same offensive success as they managed zero points vs Wisconsin last week. Early money on Rutgers, we're passing.

CINCINNATI 34 Bowling Green 13. We liked Cincinnati here and gave out the Bearcats -18 to clients and also on the Monday Covers show on YouTube. We thought Cincinnati out-played Nebraska in the second half last week and they ran for 202 yards. We watched Bowling Green in-person last week. The Falcons returned the opening kickoff for a TD but after that, it was pedestrian in a 26-7 win.

OREGON 43 Oklahoma State 15. Oklahoma State won their opener over UT-Martin 27-7 but lost QB Hejny to injury. Oregon destroyed FCS Montana State 59-13 as 29.5-point favorites. Mike Gundy probably poked the bear in the press conference this week talking about Oregon's \$40 million dollar roster. Ducks win easily.

UTSA 35 Texas State 29. This is one of the better Group of 5 games as both teams expect to be contenders in their conferences this year. Texas State destroyed UTSA 49-10 as 1.5-point favorites last year. The Bobcats also had an impressive opener as they piled up 392 rushing yards in a 52-27 win over Eastern Michigan. UTSA ran for 203 yards on Texas A&M and got a miracle cover. Our ratings lean UTSA.

COLORADO 38 Delaware 14. Colorado was fortunate to only lose by 7 to Georgia Tech last week as they were +3 in turnovers and allowed 320 rushing yards. Delaware did not impress in a 35-17 win over Delaware State as 30.5-point favorites. Early money on Colorado and true frosh QB Julian Lewis will get some action here.

WISCONSIN 38 Middle Tennessee 7. Wisconsin did not look great in a 17-0 win over Miami, OH last week. Starting QB Billy Edwards got hurt but backup Danny O'Neill has experience (starting QB at San Diego St last year). Middle Tennessee probably had the worst performance of week one. They were 15-point favorites vs Austin Peay and were dominated 34-14. Early week money is on Wisconsin.

West Virginia 31 OHIO 28. This is a dangerous game for West Virginia in game two of the Rich Rod era. Ohio nearly upset Rutgers last week as 15.5-point underdogs as QB Parker Navarro shined. West Virginia did have a 625-123 yard edge last week over Robert Morris. We bet WVU -2.5 thinking the line would close at least 3. Another sharp group is on the OVER here. We're passing at current.

FLORIDA 38 South Florida 18. USF got an impressive 34-7 upset win over Boise State as 4.5-point underdogs last week. The box score wasn't as impressive as USF was +3 in turnovers and stopped Boise on downs three times in USF territory. USF also got a long fake punt TD. Florida destroyed Long Island 55-0 (a below average FCS team). Our ratings like the Gators here.

† **ARKANSAS 42 Arkansas State 19.** @War Memorial Stadium in Little Rock, AR. These two in-state schools have never met! Both QB's impressed last week as Arkansas QB Green had 6 TD passes and Arkansas State QB Raynor was 26 of 32 for 345 yards and 3 TD's. We bet Arkansas -19.5 on the openers and another sharp group bet them at -21.5. Lean UNDER at current.

HAWAII 28 Sam Houston State 21. Like last week, this is a one-factor handicap. Will Hawaii QB Micah Alejado play or not? Right now, it looks like he will be a game-time decision. The Rainbow Warriors are 1-1 on the season coming off a pair of games vs Power 4 opponents. Sam Houston is 0-2 losing to a pair of G5 schools. Early money is on Sam Houston, we're passing for now.

MARSHALL 33 Missouri State 23. Missouri State was destroyed in their FBS opener losing 73-13 to USC. Meanwhile, Marshall lost to Georgia 45-7. The Thundering Herd used three different QB's. We don't have much interest here. There's been a couple of orders on the UNDER in this game.

North Carolina 32 CHARLOTTE 17. What an opening game disaster for both head coaches. Especially for North Carolina's Bill Belichick. After the opening drive for North Carolina, the Tar Heels were out-gained 542-139. That's what a box score looks like for a Power 4 team playing an average FCS school. Not one where the point-spread was 3.5. The market loved Charlotte last week, betting them down from 8.5 to 3-point underdogs but they were soundly beaten by Appalachian State. They do get a home game vs a NC playing on a short week. This line opened 19 and we bet Charlotte. We lean NC at current.

KANSAS STATE 33 Army 16. Kansas State's first two games have been a disaster. They lose outright in Ireland to hated rival Iowa State and then nearly lost outright to North Dakota as 27.5-point favorites. Army did lose outright to FCS Tarleton as 14-point favorites last week. Early money is on Kansas State but we're on the sidelines.

Memphis 36 GEORGIA STATE 21 21. We liked Memphis last week and so did the market as they won and covered vs Chattanooga 45-10 (-29.5). Georgia State got crushed by Ole Miss 63-7 getting out-scored 38 in the second half. We bet Memphis big at -13.5 and the market is still holding. What are we missing?

Tulane 31 SOUTH ALABAMA 20. Tulane felt disrespected by Northwestern last week as the Wildcats denied Tulane's request to honor the 20th anniversary of Hurricane Katrina. The Green Wave played like it too in their 23-3 win that put them in the early favorite for getting the G5 playoff berth. South Alabama was very pedestrian in their 38-21 win over Morgan State. We bet Tulane.

TOLEDO 31 Western Kentucky 25. This is another good Group of 5 game with both having conference championship aspirations. WKU is 2-0 straight up and ATS off two comfortable home wins. Toledo is 0-1 but got a late cover vs Kentucky in a 24-16 loss. Early money has been on Toledo, but we preferred the UNDER.

Houston 27 RICE 13. Rice got a big upset win in the debut of head coach Scott Abell as they beat UL-Lafayette 14-12 (+10). Houston got a 27-0 win over Stephen F. Austin on Thursday and now have film on Rice's new offense. We bet UNDER and the market agreed. We thought that was a pretty sharp Tuesday afternoon move on Houston as the market went from -11.5 to -14.

Vanderbilt 24 VIRGINIA TECH 23. Virginia Tech is playing with revenge after Vanderbilt upset them 34-27 as 13.5-point underdogs last year. The Hokies lost 24-11 vs South Carolina in a game they had a 336-334 yard edge. They desperately need a win. Vanderbilt covered vs Charleston Southern in the opener. We trust the Vandy staff more.

LSU 45 Louisiana Tech 7. If we had no priors baked into our power ratings, we might have LSU ranked No. 1 this week. We were very impressed with their 17-10 win at Clemson as 5-point underdogs. We graded the game more like a 24-10 or 27-10 win. Louisiana Tech had a misleading 24-0 win over SE Louisiana (see page 1). LSU and the UNDER have taken the money here. We're passing.

MICHIGAN STATE 26 Boston College 22. The NBC Saturday night game might not be intriguing to most, but this could be a swing game for both teams and programs. Both have second-year coaches. Both won their opener. Yes, BC won their opener 66-10 as new QB Loneragan threw 4 TD's. However, we liked what we saw from Michigan St. They should have covered (see bad beats on page 1). We're expecting a good atmosphere. We gave out Michigan State -2.5 to clients and also on our Monday Covers YouTube show. We can't recommend it at current. Make sure you tune in every Monday (see page 1).

AUBURN 48 Ball State 6. You have to be impressed with Auburn's week one performance. Number one, they went on the road and played a quality opponent. Number two, they easily won the trenches as they out-rushed Baylor 307-64. You can't say the same for Ball State as they lost 31-0 to Purdue. Auburn can name their score. The market likes the UNDER but so far we're passing.

NEBRASKA 41 Akron 7. Nebraska won a close game, something they have not done for so many years. The problem for us is that they allowed 202 rushing yards and despite being +2 in turnovers, they didn't cover. They shouldn't worry this week against a hapless Akron team that lost 10-0 on their home field to Wyoming last week.

Arizona State 32 MISSISSIPPI STATE 26. While it won't move the needle nationally, this is a solid match-up. ASU won last year's game 30-23 as 5.5-point home favorites. Last week, we came away more impressed with Miss St as they won and covered at Southern Miss while ASU failed to cover at home vs Northern Arizona. Our ratings like ASU here but our gut is telling us Miss St is the sharper side.

OKLAHOMA 24 Michigan 21. Easily the biggest game of the week and the ABC Saturday Night matchup. Both failed to cover last week in rather pedestrian efforts. However, both new QB's looked good. Michigan true freshman Bryce Underwood was 21 of 31 for 251 yards. Oklahoma transfer John Mateer was 30 of 37 for 392 yards. Michigan starting LB Barham will miss the first half. We think UM fairs well at the line of scrimmage as RB Justice Haynes ran for 159 yards and 3 TD's. That's why we like them getting north of a FG.

USC 45 Georgia Southern 17. Former USC head coach Clay Helton faces the school who fired him (correctly so). The Trojans were dominant in their 73-13 win over Missouri State last week. Meanwhile, Georgia Southern was out-scored 32-0 in the second half at Fresno State. They are staying in Oxnard, CA all week and we think that will be a positive. We don't see value though at current.

ALABAMA 43 UL-Monroe 9. We don't like to over-react to small sample sizes. However, we are officially out on Alabama in 2025 (after picking them to win it all) and we are out on Kalen DeBoer at Alabama. Coming off a disappointing 2024 season where Alabama lost 3 times as a 2-TD or more favorite, the Crimson Tide lost outright again as a 2-TD favorite to Florida State. Losing outright is one thing, getting dominated at the line of scrimmage is another. DeBoer is now 6-4 vs unranked teams at Alabama. Nick Saban was 124-4 in such games. ULM should have covered vs St. Francis last week (see bad beats page 1). We lean ULM and OVER at current.

Ucla 28 UNLV 25. UCLA's blowout loss last week was pathetic on so many levels. First, the score...43-10 as 6.5-point dogs to Utah. Second, transfer QB Nico was 11 of 22 for 136 yards. Finally, only 35,000 showed up at the Rose Bowl and lots of them were Utah fans. This program is a joke and now they're in the wrong conference. UNLV looked much improved in game 2 last week. Pass.

Tulsa 27 NEW MEXICO STATE 24. The market loves this Tulsa team. They bet OVER 3.5 wins in the summer, they bet them last week (won 35-14 vs Abilene -5.5) and they're betting them this week. We think laying more than a FG is pretty steep in our ratings.

BYU 34 Stanford 14. Stanford comes in off a bye after losing to Hawaii in Week Zero. We will see if they can figure out a passing attack. BYU destroyed FCS Portland State 69-0 with a 468-(-5) rushing edge. We bet BYU as we expect Stanford's offense to struggle.

San Diego State 24 WASHINGTON STATE 23. The market loved Washington St last week as they bet them from -13.5 to -16.5. The market was wrong as they should have lost outright to Idaho. Meanwhile San Diego State pummeled Stony Brook 42-0 with a 453-93 yard edge. We bet San Diego State big on the openers but unfortunately a service released them on Sunday early. We'll still call for the upset.

Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 5 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Penn State -41.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is one of the first books in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). In 2023, we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). So far this season we are 18-7 72% (CLV 24-1 +2.94 ppg) Below is some of what we bet already for Week 2 which includes bets we made in the summer for this week.

Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, September 4th

PHILADELPHIA 27 Dallas 20. The defending Super Bowl Champs kick off the 2025 season. That's been a regular trend the last 20 years as the champs are 11-7-2 ATS in such games. We've seen a recent market move on Philly here as the Micah Parsons trade to Green Bay has dampened expectations in Dallas. We're not wild about laying more than a TD especially in division games. If you've bet dogs and unders in Week 1 the last four years you are 76-52 (59.4%). That's where our leans are here.

Friday, September 5th

† **Kansas City 24 L.A. Chargers 22.** @*Corinthians Arena in Sao Paulo Brazil.* Great way to kick off the NFL opening weekend for a Friday night game in Brazil on You Tube. The NFL knows it has the strongest brand in the United States and are starting to flex their muscles. It features a pair of AFC playoff teams with high hopes. Jim Harbaugh is 5-0 ATS in openers and there has clearly been a Super Bowl loser hangover. Since 2000, the Super Bowl loser is just 6-19 ATS in Week 1 of the next season. A couple of groups we trust are actually on the Chiefs here. We're looking to bet the Chargers especially if we see more "+3.5's" show in the market (available now at a few books). Keep an eye on the field conditions here.

Sunday, September 7th

Pittsburgh 20 N.Y. JETS 17. Obviously, the big story here is Aaron Rodgers getting the start vs his former team. Right now Rodgers is a below average QB at best. Meanwhile, the Jets are starting a bottom 5 QB in Justin Fields. Aaron Glenn is the new head coach in New York, we don't have high expectations and neither does the market. Meanwhile, the Steelers haven't won a playoff game in 8 years, their longest stretch since the 1970 merger. An ugly game with no orders coming across our desk on side or total.

Miami 24 INDIANAPOLIS 23. Daniel Jones will get the start for the Colts. Indy has been the worst team in the NFL recently in Week 1 with a horrific 2-14-1 SU and ATS mark. Meanwhile, the Dolphins still have Mike McDaniel and Tua Tagovailoa. We're not big fans of either but usually this team performs well early in the season especially indoors on a fast track. A group we respect likes the Colts at pick. We lean the other way.

JACKSONVILLE 25 Carolina 22. Jacksonville has been notorious for failing to meet expectations as they are 19-6 if you've been betting their win total UNDER every year since 2000. QB Trevor Lawrence also doesn't handle expectations well as he has a losing record outright as a favorite. However, we're not fans of the QB on the other side either in Bryce Young. With that said, we could only look at the dog at "+3.5".

WASHINGTON 24 N.Y. Giants 20. We've seen quite a few Giants orders come across our desk in recent weeks. Whether it is win total OVER 5.5 or multiple hits at +6 in this game, expectations are starting to rise. We're not true believers of Russell Wilson at this stage in his career and he is just 2-6-1 ATS in season openers since 2015 Washington comes off a great first season under Jayden Daniels. Washington was 150-1 to win the Super Bowl and they made it all the way to the NFC Championship game. How do they handle expectations now? We like the Giants as divisional dogs are on a 23-7 ATS run since 2010 in week one.

Cincinnati 24 CLEVELAND 20. Cincinnati has typically started off seasons slow. They are 1-9 SU and 3-7 ATS in the first two games of the season with Joe Burrow under center. We do like their new DC Al Golden but he doesn't have much to work with personnel wise. Historically, the Browns are just 3-23-1 straight up in openers since 1995. Joe Flacco will get the start. We did see quite a few Cleveland orders come across our desk at "+6". We still lean that way at current.

NEW ENGLAND 24 Las Vegas 21. A pair of first-year coaches that have seen their expectations rise this off-season. New England's win total last year was 4.5. The Patriots won 4 games. This year their win total is 8.5 as they welcome back Mike Vrabel. This is the first time they have been favored in a game going back to 2023. Pete Carroll is back in the NFL and he will turn to his former Seattle starting QB Geno Smith. We do like the staff that Carroll has assembled. Tough game to handicap but we've seen some recent support for OVER.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Arizona 24 NEW ORLEANS 18. Spencer Rattler is the worst starting QB in the NFL. He's 1-5 ATS in his 6 games as a starter and should be a backup, not a starter. How about the market making Kyler Murray a 6.5-point road favorite? Tough to trust him in that role. The sharp side we saw in this game over the summer was the UNDER and we still lean that way.

Tampa Bay 23 ATLANTA 22. Baker Mayfield vs Michael Penix here. We definitely aren't huge fans of Mayfield and the jury is out on Penix. Usually, division dogs are the way to go at home in Week 1. The UNDER is one of our favorite plays in week 1. We also wouldn't mind teasing Atlanta here even with teaser prices at most shops going up.

DENVER 25 Tennessee 17. NFL rookie QB's starting on the road are 8-21 SU and 13-14-2 ATS. No. 1 overall pick QB's in their first start have been worse with a 5-22-1 SU and 8-20 ATS mark. Denver was great ATS wise last year with Bo Nix under center but it was their defense that really led the way. We were tipped off that this line could be on the rise and that's what we've seen in the market the last few days. Still, we're not wild about laying this kind of number in week one unless you throw the Broncos in a teaser.

San Francisco 22 SEATTLE 20. Seattle has been a very strong home team including a 9-1 SU record in home openers. However, has that home record caught up to them in the betting markets? They were 2-7 ATS last year failing to cover by 3.7 points per game and have the second worst ATS mark at home the last four years. Much is expected of San Francisco after their dismal 2024 season. The orders we've seen on this game have been on the 49ers and the UNDER. We prefer the UNDER.

GREEN BAY 24 Detroit 22. A huge game in the NFC to open up the season. Dan Campbell is 11-3 ATS in September. If you have blindly bet on him and the Lions in every regular season game the last 4 years, you are 47-20-1 ATS (70%). Those are NFL records for any team in any 4-year period going back 35 years. However, Green Bay head coach Matt LaFleur is 15-3 ATS in the first 3 games of the season including 7-0 ATS at home. Detroit has won 6 of the last 7 meetings but we're calling for Green Bay here especially with Detroit losing both coordinators.

L.A. RAMS 23 Houston 20. Two playoff teams that want to continue their successful runs. Initially there was some doubts on healthy Matthew Stafford would be at the start of the season but he is expected to start here. We've seen some support for the Rams recently and we also saw an UNDER order awhile back. Not sure how involved we will be here.

Baltimore 25 BUFFALO 24. An awesome Sunday Night NBC game to open up the season with a pair of teams that can't get over the Patrick Mahomes and Kansas City hump in the AFC. A rematch of last year's AFC Divisional playoff game which the Bills won a thriller 27-25. Baltimore head coach John Harbaugh usually does well in these types of games with a 12-5 ATS mark in Week 1. Lamar Jackson is 12-3 ATS as an underdog in his career and if the Ravens close as underdogs, it will be the first time in that role since the 2023 season.

Monday, September 8th

CHICAGO 22 Minnesota 21. A lot of love for Minnesota in this game earlier this summer. A lot of unknowns for us as JJ McCarthy will get his first start for the Vikings. Minnesota greatly over-achieved expectations last year going over their win total by 7.5 games (first team in 20 years to do so). On the other side, Chicago has a new coach in Ben Johnson and we will see. Again even with teaser prices going up, we don't mind a final weekend leg of Bears +7.5 and we'll call for them to win the game outright.
