

I CAN DO ALL THINGS THROUGH CHRIST WHO STRENGTHENS AND EMPOWERS ME

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Vision/Imagination - Part 7 By Wade Anderson

In everything we do, as being in Christ, we need to picture ourselves as successful. Look at this from God's perspective, "For everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world? Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God." (1 John 5:4-5) and recognize that Jesus made us ALL overcomers! How awesome is it that He has made us victors, that He has made us blessed, healed, healthy and whole, that He is the One that has made us prosper and gives us His peace. As we read these things it all looks great on the pages, but often times we have a harder time switching from thinking about our physical circumstances and past experiences. And that's exactly what the enemy wants us to do, stay focused on the natural things in front of us instead of the spiritual realm that is VERY MUCH real to the believer. What I'm saying is this, most battles take place in our own minds. And that's because we need to be more focused on what the Word of God states than what our natural circumstances are showing us. 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 shows us, "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ."

Spiritual warfare is not a battle of good versus evil, Jesus has already won that battle. For us, as believers, spiritual warfare is a battle for our faith, and generally wages right between our ears. In many of the New Testament Scriptures about spiritual warfare I found focus on the mind and the imagination. I'm not saying that demons and angels aren't real, I do believe they are real! The more that I myself deal with these very issues, the more I realize the only way they can control or influence my life is IF they can capture my imagination and cause me to walk by sight instead of by faith. We see here in *2 Corinthians 10:4, "For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds."* Even as Christians we are still human and in our own human strength, we'll NEVER have enough power or resources to win that battle in and of ourselves. Scripture here tells us that the weapons of our warfare, the power to knock down the strongholds of the devil are NOT carnal. The Greek word used here for 'carnal' is *SARKIKOS*, **4559**, which actually means to be governed by human nature and strength as opposed to being governed by *God's Spirit*.

You may be asking, "So how do we see the victory?" Here in 2 Corinthians 10:5, Paul tells us, "Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ." Let's look over at Romans 2:15, "Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another." The same Greek word LOG/SMOS, 3053, is translated "thoughts' here in Romans 2:15. Let's look at Romans 2:15 (NIV), "They show that the requirements of the law are written on their hearts, their consciences also bearing witness, and their thoughts sometimes accusing them and at other times even defending them." As far as I can tell, these is the only two times this Greek word is used in the New Testament. I did find, in Reinecker's Linguistic key to the Greek New Testament this same word means calculation, reasoning, reflection, thought. It seems like this is telling us that the imagination is the part of us that calculates, reasons, reflects and thinks. Would you agree?

Even as Christians, many of us still believe that the devil is a powerful force. Why? And again, I'm not saying that he doesn't exist, and I know that I've covered this many times before, even with a time relevant visual that Paul had painted for the church in Colossae. These Scriptures are the fundamental foundation to our faith. *Colossians 2:13-15* has affirmed to us, (While) "You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ (more of your identity), for He forgave ALL our sins. He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross. In this way, He disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by His victory over them on the cross." Many of us see the Scripture reference, James 4:7, and can instantly quote, "Resist the devil and he will flee from you." Could it be because we are still looking at spiritual warfare as the devil being the 'strong man'? If that's the case, then we will never see great victory in the area of spiritual warfare. What we have failed to acknowledge is the "Submit yourselves to God" part, our part. THEN when we submit ourselves to God, we acknowledge that God is the source of our power. The crazy thing about this is the devil already knows he's been defeated. He's throwing all his chips in the ring betting that 'you' don't know it! God has an order for everything.

Here in Matthew 12:29 Jesus is assuring us of the power of God's Spirit. Jesus said, "For who is powarful arough to anter the house of a strong man and plander his goods? Only someone avan stronger—someone who could the him up and then plander his house," In this Scripture the 'strong man' does represent satan while Jesus and you are the "someone avan stronger". As we reread Luke's account of Jesus being tempted by satan in Luke 4:5-7, we see, "The devil led Him up to a high place and showed him in an instant all the kingdoms of the world. And he said to Him, 'I will give you all their authority and splendor; it has been given to me, and I can give it to anyone I want to. If you worship me, it will all be Yours."" What's interesting is that satan led Jesus up to the highest place. Why? Well,

from down on the desert floor there was no way for him to pitch his appeal of the "great splendor and authority" that he was offering Jesus.

It's like driving across Phoenix, you only see the city from one level, street level. **BUT**, if you were to drive, from north to south, on Central Ave you'd wind your way up the switchbacks and end up on top of South Mountain Park. Instantly our perspective has been broadened, and now we are able see for miles and miles in every direction. In the evening this is an amazing and most beautiful sight. From there you can see over 20 different cities and towns and a total of over 517 square miles. So, you can see why the devil thought that showing Jesus from this perspective, would change His mind.

This was the last temptation in *Matthew 4*, the pride of life, that Jesus overcame. Each time He was tempted in *Matthew* 4, it was to show each of us that, in Christ, we too can overcome these very same obstacles! The liar might have tricked Eve with his deception, but did he really believe he could get Jesus to fold this easy? When the devil said to Jesus, in *Matthew 4:6, "If You are the Son of God, throw yourself down,"* he knew exactly who Jesus was. At all of these temptations Jesus always said, "Bits written," Maybe that's why satan said, "For it is written," and then quoted Psalm 91:11-12, "For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone." The devil KNEW who Jesus was, just like he knows who we are in Christ. Just like he had no power or authority over Jesus, he has NO power over any believer, that you don't give him!

Both Jesus and satan were on a mission to accomplish certain specific things. So how is it that satan could say that he had been given authority over all that they were looking at? 2 Corinthians 4:4 references this very thing, "Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don't understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God." Let me ask you all this, "Do you just read Scripture and fail to look at punctuation and specific words? Recognizing punctuation is many times very forthtelling. Something like an exclamation mark or a question mark shows us the attitude. A question mark indicates this is something for us to think about and not just a statement. Notice in this Scripture Paul does NOT say that satan is a capital 'G' god. I also understand that some translations don't always capitalize some things the way that I'm describing here. So, it's up to you to know the difference. This is why, in the newsletters, I do capitalize some things. Again, remember those Scriptures in Colossians where Jesus disarmed him and made a public spectacle of him. Here's another reference to both satan's agenda and Jesus' agenda. "The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work." (1 John 3:8)

So how did satan get this said power and who gave it to him? In *Genesis 1* God created everything and then He created man, Adam, in His own likeness and His image. Creating Adam, He gave him the authority to rule over everything else that was created. By *Genesis 3:1*, Scripture says, "Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the *Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden?"* Notice that satan got Eve alone, separate from Adam. The reason he did this was because it was Adam that God said these things to, not Eve. Everyone knows that the story tends to be told or understood differently by the time it's told by the second or third party, right? That's when, *"The woman said to the serpent, 'We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die."' (Genisis 3:2-3) Right here it's important to note that God didn't say <i>"you must not touch it"*. This is what God said in Genesis 2:16-17, *"You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; BUT YOU MUST NOT EAT from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die."*

It's just satan's nature to lie and twist the truth, he just can't help himself. The same way satan made Eve forget all that God had given her, he also tells us the same lies. Just like Eve, when we dwell on what God has forbidden, instead of the countless blessings and promises we have, in Christ, we've opened the door for him to come in and chip away at our faith. I've found for myself, the quickest way to pull out of what I don't have is to look over my life, and this reminds me of ALL that I do have. Sometime this happens a little sooner than others, but remembering the goodness of God always lifts my spirit and my countenance.

Let's continue with Genesis 3:4-6, "'You will not certainly die,' the serpent said to the woman. 'For God knows that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.' When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it." Right here is where Adam gave his authority over to satan to become the 'god' of this world. Like 2 Corinthians 4:4 states, satan blinds the minds of those who don't believe. This shouldn't be an easy task for him in a Christians life, but sadly enough it is.

Our enemy, satan, has used the same old lies and deception since he was thrown from the heavens. The same way he

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Foot's Bible Study

Hosea 4:1-7:16

God explained the reasons for Israel's suffering. Their lawless behavior has brought the twin judgments of increased violence and ecological crisis. There is not always a direct cause-and-effect relationship between our actions and the problems we face. Nevertheless, when we are facing difficulties, we should seriously ask, "Have I done anything sinful or irresponsible that has caused my suffering?" If we discover that we are at fault, even partially, we must change our ways before God will help us. (4:1-3)

God sees and knows everything. We, like Israel, often forget this. Thoughts like, "No one will ever know," or "No one is watching," may tempt us to try to get away with sin. If you are facing difficult temptations, you will be less likely to give in if you remind yourself that God is watching. When faced with the opportunity to sin, remember that God sees everything. (7:1-2)

By the time Israel began to experience the consequences of its sins, it was no longer listening to God's messengers. Refusing to hear the truth from prophets who spoke out so clearly about its sins, the nation did not hear God's warnings about what was soon to happen. We all listen and read selectively, focusing on what seems to support our preset lifestyle and ignoring a radical reordering of our priorities. In doing this, we are likely to miss the warning signs. Listen to the people who think your approach is all wrong. Read articles that present viewpoints you would be unlikely to take. Ask yourself, "Is God speaking to me through these speakers and writers? Is there something I need to change?" (9:7)

1 John 4:1-5:21

Some people believe everything they read or hear. Unfortunately, many ideas printed or taught are not true. Christians should have faith, but they should not be gullible. Verify every message you hear, even if the person who brings it says it's from God. If the message is truly from God, it will be consistent with Christ's teachings. (4:1,3)

The emphasis here is on God's will, not our will. When we communicate with God, we don't demand what we want: rather we discuss with Him what He wants for us. If we align our prayers to His will, He will listen and we can be certain that if He listens, He will give us a definite answer. Start praying with confidence. (5:14-15)

Psalms 125:1-5

Have you ever known people who were drawn to every new fad or idea? Such people are unstable and therefore unreliable. The secret to stability is to trust in God, because He never changes. He cannot be shaken by the changes in our world, and He endures forever. The fads and ideas of our world, and our world itself will not. (125:1)

Proverbs 29:9-11

The fool's and scumbags hate honest people, but the upright and good people seek out the honest. (29:10)

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deceived Eve, he does his best to do to us. Adam and Eve had God Himself to fellowship with on a daily basis. They didn't have any concept of evil in their lives or around them. But the second they allowed themselves to be deceived, their whole world turned upside down. They had nothing but goodness to reflect on, until satan put thoughts of 'what they didn't have' in their minds. The liar is always doing the same thing to us. This is why it's important for us to always reflect on the goodness of God in our lives. As we reflect on the many great things God has done in our lives it builds our hope and strengthens or faith. Remembering God's goodness makes it easier to see that He is faithful in ALL things.

In Joshua 3:9-17 Joshua was leading the Israelites through the Jorden River into the promised land. Joshua 3:15-17 tells us, "Now the Jordan is at flood stage all during harvest. Yet as soon as the priests who carried the ark reached the Jordan and their feet touched the water's edge, the water from upstream stopped flowing. It piled up in a heap a great distance away, at a town called Adam in the vicinity of Zarethan, while the water flowing down to the Sea of the Arabah (that is, the Dead Sea) was completely cut off. So the people crossed over opposite Jericho. The priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the Lord stopped in the middle of the Jordan and stood on dry ground, while all Israel passed by until the whole nation had completed the crossing on dry ground." What an amazing event! As soon as the soles of the priests carrying the Ark of Covenant touched the floor of the river, the water stood straight up on one side while downstream the water dried up. As the priests stood in the middle of the river, the whole nation of Israel crossed on dry ground. Can you imagine the things going through their heads as they watched not only the river stand up on one side dry up, but that the river bottom was completely dry, no mud, as they ALL crossed through the river bottom?

I love what the Lord spoke to Joshua in Joshua 4:2-3, "Choose twelve men from among the people, one from each tribe, and tell them to take up twelve stones from the middle of the Jordan, from right where the priests are standing, and carry them over with you and put them down at the place where you stay tonight." Consider this: Why would God tell them to get 'stones' from the middle of the Jordan River? Why not just use the stones from outside the river, on the banks of the river, they'd be much easier to access? Then, Joshua gives them further instruction, in Joshua 4:5-7, "Go over before the ark of the Lord your God into the middle of the Jordan. Each of you is to take up a stone on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the Israelites, to serve as a sign among you. In the future, when your children ask you, 'What do these stones mean?' tell them that the flow of the Jordan was cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord. When it crossed the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. These stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel forever." I want to point out that these 'stones' were NOT something that one could carry in their hands. No! Joshua said, "Each of you take up a stone on his shoulders." If they were to carry them out on their shoulders, these 'stones' were actually large rocks! Sure, it would be easier to build this monument out of the stones on the banks of the Jordan River. But that wouldn't tell a great story that took place there. The rocks on the banks of the river wouldn't look like the ones from the center of the river. God knew the greater story or testimony would come from the 'stones' from the floor of the river. River rocks have been rolling and tumbling in the river for many, many years. They have no sharp edges on them like those from the bank. With the 'stones' from the center of the river floor, it would tell something much greater took place at this exact spot. God wanted this spot to be a memorial to everyone that pasted by for generations to come. With this monument/marker God wanted the people to always remember the miraculous thing that He had done for His people. I love this!

Remember that motorcycle accident I had at the end of our street 17 years ago? I'm not sure how this happened but in the very spot where I hit the ground a 5-gallon bucket of white paint hit and splattered over the road from where I hit the ground all the way to where the motorcycle and dog finally stopped! Whenever I drive by there or walk past there it always serves as a monument to where my life took such a drastic change. Every time I pass by there with my grandsons, I always tell them, "Do you see where that white paint is? That's where God got my undivided attention, came into my life and gave me the vision/mission of the OC+C ministry." Over the years, I've told them all about this spot, but Anthony has heard it so many times that as soon as we approach it, and even before I mention anything he always says, "YES! Grandpa you always tell me this same story! I know! You hit a dog with Frankie behind you on your motorcycle and you gave your life to Jesus that day! You've told me this 1000 times!"

Now that he's a little older I'm able to share with him that this spot is a memorial to the Lord. It is a representation of the mighty thing God did in me 17 years ago. I can now relate to him this story in Joshua and how it's a similar type of place for me. I NEVER want my grandchildren to forget what God did in my life, right there. At that very spot in the road, God not only changed my life, but has also touched Michelle's life, and ALL of my children and grandchildren lives. One can only imagine the countless number of lives that have been touched, through this newsletter ministry! Here's another thing. It's been 17 years, and that paint is STILL there! The city has never done anything to our street, no street repairs, no seal coat or anything to cover over that paint!! PRAISE JESUS!

And again, why am I telling you all about all of these events in my life? Because life happens, and there will be many

times your faith will be tested. It's generally when we focus more on the test instead of the Solution, that we have a greater tendency to fall. It doesn't matter what comes at you, if you turn from entertaining what the liar is trying to show you and focus on the goodness of God and what He has **ALREADY** done in your life, your focus changes causing your hope to rise inside of you. Here's something else. I've encouraged you all to write down the things God has shown you, spoken to you, and even done in your life. This is a good thing to reflect on from time to time. Now, do you think for even a second that when satan charges you with his lies that he is going to sit on a chair and wait for you to run get your notebook? **NO!** Absolutely not!

I've told you from the beginning of this message that I have everything I've shared with you in these pages written down in a notepad.
