

Municipality of Shuniah
Class Environmental Assessment
Replacement of the Scott Drive Culvert
Public Comment Invited

The Municipality of Shuniah is investigating the problem of recurring flooding and roadway washouts at a culvert on Scott Drive. The culvert is located approximately 250 metres west of the intersection of Scott Drive and Birch Beach Road in Shuniah, Ontario. It passes the flow of the Birch Beach Creek beneath the roadway towards Lake Superior. Options to address the problem include the replacement of the existing culvert with a new steel, multi-plate arch culvert on concrete footings.

The project is being planned under **Schedule B** of the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**.

Public input and comment are invited for incorporation into the planning and design of this project, and will be received until April 4, 2018. Subject to comments received and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Municipality of Shuniah intends to proceed with the planning, design, and construction of this project, to be completed by late 2018.
