It is time to get ready for Fall! Here is a block that we can use fall fabrics and even use up some of our scraps! We will be paper piecing the Jack O'Lantern - there are 6 sections that we will be piecing together to create the Jack O'Lantern. Please try to print out the 3 pages of paper piecing for the Jack O'Lantern and bring to class.

Finished block is 11"

For a 6" finished Jack O'Lantern you can print at 70%

Materials and Supplies needed:

- Fabric for the Jack O'Lantern
 - o Feel free to bring larger scrap pieces but here is a guideline for sizes
 - o Gray (Background) – 1/5 yard
 - 13" by 2.5" Strips
 - o Dark Orange – 10" pieces
 - o Light Orange – 7" pieces
 - o Black – 7" pieces
 - o Brown – 2.5" pieces
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Ruler & Cutting Mat
- If you have one, Add-a-Quarter Ruler
- If you have one, Wooden press would be helpful – finger pressing will suffice and there will be a few irons set up around the room
